TATTLER buddy (and fellow Rotisserie League member) Judd Zulgad - columnist for the *Minneapolis Star-Tribune* - shared a story worth telling this week, showing how newspaper people and radio people sometimes just don't mix. Last weekend, at the PGA Championship tournament held in Minneapolis, Judd ran into **Bryan Burwell**, the newest *St.* Louis Post-Dispatch sports columnist (and former writer for USAToday and Baseball Weekly), who wanted to capture the mood of a state that might see its first-place Twins – a team targeted for contraction just a few months ago - go on strike. On his way to the golf course to cover Tigermania, he tuned into Clear Channel sports KFAN. Once at the course, Burwell found where the station was set up at and began to talk off-air to Dan (The Common Man) Cole, who is on before Chad Hartman. The only problem is Burwell thought he was talking to Hartman. The next day, he mistakenly quoted Hartman in the Post-Dispatch as saying: "Nobody cares anymore. We got two phone calls on it all day, maybe three. You have to remember what this town has already gone through. The sad fact is, we're no longer a baseball town. Nobody cares anymore." But it was the volatile, shoot-from-the-hip, tell-it-like-he-thinks-it-is Cole who gave him the quote, not the well-measured, always 'PC' Hartman. Needless to say, the gaffe caused an uproar. Twins sportscasters (and former KCLD night jock) Dick Bremer and future HOF'er Bert Blyleven took Hartman to task during last Saturday night's Twins telecast on Fox Sports Net. Blyleven said "Hartman should apologize to the viewers and listeners," and said he would not go on Hartman's show again. That led to a near-altercation as Hartman sought out Burwell the next day in the press tent at the PGA and told Burwell that the statement has been made by Cole. Burwell said his heart sank and he "apologized about 15" different ways." He left Hartman another apology on his voice mail Monday. Said Burwell, "I did the stupidest thing in the world. I assumed I knew who I was talking to" and offered to go on Hartman's show "to tell everybody I'm the moron." According to Judd, Hartman probably won't take Burwell up on the offer but appreciated the newspaper guy owning up to the mistake. Said Hartman, "These things happen."
