According to reports from **Jon Ellis'** "Northpine" Midwest Broadcasting News website, sister stations "Mix 105" WLMX/Balsam Lake, WI and "Oldies 105.7" WXCX/Siren, WI have new management. **Quarnstrom Media** took over the stations on Tuesday under a Local Marketing Agreement (LMA). Quarnstrom owns eleven other stations in the region, including AM/FM combos in Hayward, WI and Pine City, MN. In an unrelated move, WLMX Program Director/Morning Host **Adam McCune** has exited the station.

Green Bay based Starboard Broadcasting has entered the Twin Cities market. The company is operating 1530 KSMM/Shakopee, MN and 740 WMIN/Hudson, WI as of this week. KSMM flipped from the contemporary Spanish as "La Tremenda" to Spanish-language religion (from EWTN networks) in July, and an agreement was supposed to make Andover, MN's Twin Hears Media the owners of the station. However, Twin Hearts were unable to complete the sale, marking the second failed sale of the station in two years (grocery market owner Selwin Ortega's Las Americas Corporation had attempted to purchase the station earlier). Starboard has now taken control of KSMM, retaining its current Spanish religious format. Meanwhile, KSMM now has an unlikely sister station in the other corner of the Twin Cities area, as Jim Borgen agrees to give Starboard control of his 740 WMIN daytime-only signal. On Tuesday, WMIN dropped its syndicated sports format known as "The Zone" in favor of English-language religious programming from the EWTN network. Recently, "The Zone" had been tickling the bottom of the Twin Cities Arbitrons for the first time in many years; not bad for a daytimer across the Wisconsin border!

The same week as it entered the Twin Cities market (see above story), **Starboard Broadcasting** is buying 100.1 WGLB-FM/Port Washington, WI. Currently broadcasting '70s Oldies, the suburan-Milwaukee signal (owned by **Joel J. Kinlow**), delivers a fair signal across much of the Milwaukee area. Starboard plans to change the format to religion from EWTN network. The call letters of WGLB-FM will have to change, since Kinlow will retain ownership of 1560 WGLB/Elm Grove, as well as TV 49 WJJA/Racine.

Following his emergency appendectomy last Thursday (9/26) morning Sports WSCR/Chicago update anchor **Joe Bartosch** recuperated quick enough to be back on the gig producing the Bears football game for sister News WBBM-A on Sunday (9/29) and on update duties for The Score the following day. Joe reportedly remained on a limited schedule for the rest of this past week at WSCR, WBBM, and his other job in affiliate relations at **Mediatracks**.
