In addition, Java would join **Drex** the following morning for listeners to address the issue. Jive VP/Promotion **Denise George** responded favorably to the stations disciplinary action, calling it "...a very appropriate decision by WKSC." Conclave rumor #1: Doc Wynter?

According to reports from today's *Minneapolis Star-Tribune*, **Minnesota Public Radio**'s "Mid-Morning" host and former *St. Paul Pioneer Press* columnist **Katherine Lanpher** was arrested April 12th on charges of driving while intoxicated and leaving the scene of an accident. The paper reports that Lanpher, who allegedly hit another car and then left the scene, has not yet been formally charged, and that her blood-alcohol content was .21, over twice the legal limit.

Conclave rumor #2: Sam Weaver?

Following the stunting at **Woodward Communication's** CHR WKSZ/Green Bay, the station flipped to a HAC presentation as "Mix 95-9, Today's Best Variety" under PD **Dayton Kane** Monday at 5pm. Dayton tells *The TAT-TLER* that the staff will remain intact. However, the station will remain jockless for the next month as jocks take advantage of this music intensive period to concentrate on imaging and street level presence in the market.

Conclave rumor #3: Bob Coburn?

At long last the lawsuit by two men whom had claimed to have taken KORB/Quad Cities, IL-IA jock **Ben Stone**'s off-handed remark to heart (getting the station's name tattooed on their foreheads) has been dismissed. The pair, **Richard "Boy Genius" Goddard** and his step-father **David "The Brainiac" Winkelman**, had sued **Cumulus**, Ben Stone and the station for not paying them \$30,000 a year for 5 years as Stone allegedly remarked during a promo for a temporary tattoo, and the station allegedly confirmed on the phone and in person. As a result of Goddard failing to appear for a deposition and hearing, the suit was dismissed. However, it may still be refiled.



According to reports from the St. Louis Post-Dispatch, Bonneville's Country WIL/St. Louis has announced that it will no longer carry Jones Radio Network's Syndicated Country host Lia following being named in a discrimination complaint, along with JRN, filed with the Missouri Human Rights Commission on (4/2) by Robert A. Tart of St. Louis. Mr. Tart, who speaks with a significant stutter, listens to the Lia show on WIL and called to make a request on the evening of (3/21) when assistant producer Alexa reportedly responded, "Bobby, we don't do the stuttering thing." WIL claims that they had not planned to renew the contract in favor of local broadcasting but moved up the timeline in light of the recent incident. Meanwhile, JRN VP/GM **Jim LaMarca** issued the following statement: "Jones has a written policy of non discrimination that every employee is given. Discrimination is not tolerated. This unfortunate incident is a reminder to all of us in this industry that we must be extremely sensitive to our listeners. It is incumbent up on all of us to take the extra time and effort to treat all of our listeners with the respect and dignity they deserve. We apologized to Mr. Tart before this became public and we apologize again today. In fact we would like to have him on the Lia show as soon as possible to make his request and even speak to the issue of discrimination he has faced in his life."
