He spun through his repertoire, receiving prolonged applause after each classic: "Crazy," "Nightlife," "Blue Eyes Crying In the Rain," "Red-Headed Stranger," "On The Road Again," and more. When asked by Helton to name his favorite Willie song, Nelson responded: "All of them." He told a dirty joke, reveled in his #1 country record ("Beer For My Horses" with Toby Keith), and then left to a standing ovation, which lasted for several minutes. Upon Willie's departure, one veteran record executive remarked, "That had to be the highlight of my life!"



It looks like the long-rumored changes at 560 WEBC/Duluth are going to become reality on Monday morning. **Clear Channel** recently acquired the station from **Regent Broadcasting**, and plans to air its regionally-syndicated "Fan Network" programming on the station. In a press release on Thursday, the Company said that Fan programming will air 6am to 7pm weekdays, and 6am to 2pm Sundays. The remaining schedule has not yet been announced. In the changeover, **Dave Kuharski** and two other part-timers will exit the station. "The **Rush Limbaugh** Show" will be displaced, as well as **Hubbard Radio Network's** KSTP (AM)-based **Joe Soucheray** program. Veteran local host **Lew Latto** will also be displaced, but is announcing that he will be heard somewhere on the dial on Monday morning. **Dave Walter** will retain his post as WEBC Program Director. Market analysts expect that **Midwest Communications** will pick up some of the displaced programs as it owns three AM signals in the market, but no firm plans have been announced so far.
