The class A station will use 810W at 159m, and will presumably be used to relay 90.9 KUNI/ Cedar Falls. KUNI is currently heard in Dubuque on a translator at 98.7. Also, Heartland Christian Broadcasters has turned in the licenses of four translators in Northern Minnesota (101.7 W269AP/Aurora, 95.3 W237AF/Buhl, 103.9 W280CO/Gilbert, and 100.9 K265DD/Grand Rapids). The first three translators were transferred from JPI Radio earlier this year and were once part of the Christian hard rock WAKX Iron Range translator network. The Grand Rapids translator was replaced with a former JPI translator on 95.1. The North Dakoka Department of Transportation has received two more construction permits for low-power signals (100 Watts each) on 95.7 in Minot and 96.3 Valley City.
