This week, **Arbitron** released revised Chicago Spring book data on Maximiser and Media Professional to account for reportedly inaccurate audience estimates for Triple A WXRT, after the ratings company reportedly discovered a diary-keeper inaccurately reported listening to the station from 7a-7p weekdays and 9a-9p on weekends, when in fact the person only listened to WXRT for five minutes each day. It's good the ratings giant was able to catch the error, but what if it hadn't? It appears that this one book would have – according to *Inside Radio* – "made a difference" in the market's audience estimates. In other words, one errant diary in the nation's 3rd largest market causes a republishing of results. Imagine what the same diary would have meant in a market like Duluth, Fargo or Cedar Rapids…with far fewer diaries in the marketplace. It gives one pause to wonder…

An Abuse of "Power"? Commentary - Last week's power failure in 8 states and a Canadian province -- which included Cleveland, Akron, Detroit, Windsor, New York, etc. -- underscored the importance of *local* radio in communicating with a panicked public. Ironically, less than a week after the lights went out, FCC Chairman Michael Powell unleashed his "Localism in Broadcasting" initiative...a welcome change in direction for the current FCC. The outage also underscored the importance of back-up power generation for the medium, a lesson that had apparently been lost on many operators (including 8 stations in the major market of Detroit who were STILL off the air 24 hours after the power grid went down). In communities whose stations were down for extended periods of time, those citizens should rightfully ask the stations "where the heck were you when we needed you?" The answers, if ever known, would be most interesting to hear...and even more interesting to have stashed away in each offending station's public file. (TK)
