

Minneapolis native Al Franken has joined forces with Progress Media, the company launching a liberal radio network, and the comedian/author has agreed to host a daily three-hour show. His show will reportedly occupy the noon to 3 p.m. time slot, right up against his soon-to-be arch rival, Rush Limbaugh. However, Franken promises to use a different format than Rush. "He has no one on the show but it's confrontation," Franken told the Associated Press. "His show is just him railing for three hours." The noted author/comedian plans to use interviews, calls from listeners and scripted comedy to fill up his time slot. He'll probably enlist a co-host (rumored to be Minnesota Public Radio host Katherine Lanpher). Progress Media doesn't have a name (although "Central Air" has been proffered) or a launch date, but about 65 percent of the programming has been decided. The company was bought last November by an investment group led by Mark Walsh, a former America Online executive. He told the AP that the new network has reached its first major distribution agreement with WNTD/Chicago, which is in the process of being sold to Multicultural Radio Broadcasting and will carry programming of the new Liberal Talk radio network. According to Chicago sources, Progress Media has an option to buy WNTD, once Multicultural Radio Broadcasting officially closes on its deal. Progress Media Network President Jon Sinton comments, "It's an extremely significant event for Progress Media to have clearance in the third-largest media market in the country. Combined with other markets we are close to finalizing, Progress Media will have tremendous reach right out of the box." In addition to Franken, Robert F. Kennedy Jr., Lizz Winstead (former "Daily Show" host and creator), and Mike Papantonio will host shows on the new network and USC Associate Dean/Annenberg School For Communications Martin Kaplan will host a talk show about the news media. But back to Al, he quips: "My first priority is to get sued by a right-wing jerk in order to generate interest in my new show, 'The O'Franken Factor.' Our hope is to do drug-free talk radio, although I understand it's never been done. Quite simply, my plan is to alter the political landscape, drive this radical right-wing president from office and stand as a beacon for ordinary Americans who work hard and play by the rules. Short of that, I'd just like to get on in Albany." WellÉhe IS good enough, strong enough, andÉdoggone it...people LIKE him!






