Clear Channel unveiled a new organizational structure and Regional VP lineup for their Mid-America Division, formerly known as "Delta" earlier this week, with Mid-America now being divided into five trading areas. According to Clear Channel Radio Senior VP Bruce Demps, "I've carefully chosen each Regional VP based on the individual needs of each market, experience in the region, management style and leadership abilities." The Midwest will be impacted by the identification of a VP for each of 2 regions. St. Louis Market Manager Lee Clear will oversee St. Louis, Springfield, MO and Springfield, Marion/Carbondale, IL while Wichita Market Manager Dick Harlow will supervise the Wichita, Oklahoma City, Tulsa and Lawton, OK and Wichita Falls, TX properties. Other VP's who are part of the plan: Mississippi Market Manager Kenny Windham continues as boss of the Mississippi Trading Area, while Tony Beringer becomes Regional VP for the Arkansas Trading Area, including Fayetteville, Ft. Smith and Little Rock and Tim Davies becomes Regional VP for the Memphis trading area and will continue his Market Manager duties in Memphis. You may have missed it in the brouhaha surrounding the Super Bowl 'Skin Game', but Consumers Union (the folks who publish the respected, non-partisan Consumer Reports) and the Consumer Federation of America have taken issue with your FCC. It seems that one of the FCC's key points in pushing last summer's proposed deregulation - that the 'diversity index' the FCC used to justify further media consolidation undervalued newspapers and overvalued radio and the as the public's primary choice for news - has been challenged by CU. Opinion Research Corporation conducted a survey of 1000 adults for CU and found that 61.3% of its respondents cited newspapers as their most important news source. Last summer, the FCC said that figure was only 28.8% but that 37% claimed the Internet and radio as their chief news source. CU found that figure to be only 10%! When it came to TV influence, both the FCC (29%) and CU (33.8%) were in closer agreement. Said a CU spokesperson, Gene Kimmelman - "Since newspapers are a much more important source for local news than the FCC gives them credit for, and TV is the second most important source, mergers between these two effectively eliminate diversity of viewpoints and competition of ideas in our local media, which is exactly what the FCC is supposed to protect." The Consumer Federation's Mark Cooper adds, "The FCC based its new rules on information that is just plain wrong, and as a result we can expect to see a wave of mergers and acquisitions that will spell an end to independence in our media. The FCC must go back and rewrite these rules based on reality, not myth, and protect diversity in the media." It's uncertain how the FCC conducted its research - and reached its consequent conclusions - but we highly suspect the agency relied upon the same 'intelligence' community that touted those vast arsenals of WMD's in Iraq.

KMXV/KC is called the "Mix", but last weekend it should have been "The Drive". The station's *Hooptie to Houston* Super Bowl contest was all about the road, as morning team **Rocket & Teresa** took four couples to the Super Bowl inside a beat-up 1996 Caravan...but only one couple actually made it to the gala. The winners got tickets to the game, some food, and a hotel to sleep in - the runners-up got the gaudy station logo'd van and gas money to return home on! 
