

How would you like to be in charge of a radio station promotion which received extensive television coverage NIGHTLY for the last 4 days of the spring book? That happened to Clear Channel T40 KDWB/Minneapolis this week as the **Ryan in the Morning Show** brought "Survive It & Drive It" to the airwaves. On Monday, June14, 36 people got on a rollercoaster at an area amusement park. The point of the promotion was simple. All 36 contestants were to ride on the helacious "Wild Thing" roller coaster over and over until they could stand it no longer. The last person standing (Sitting? Wretching??)) would drive away in a 2005 Toyota Scion. 9 days later, just two participants remained! Since the weekend, several local TV stations broadcast the saga of the contestants...ultimately making the final two contestants local heroines, of sort. But the contest had to end Wednesday (the day the station's agreement with the amusement park expired). What to do...what to do??? At 6:30AM, the station went live as **Dave Ryan** woke the two and told them there was only one way to end the impass. Muses PD Rob **Morris**, "(Dave) told them he had decided to end the contest with one game of Rock, Paper, Scissors' - winner take all. Both looked like they were about to cry. It was great" Listeners called to protest, and TV cameras recorded the whole spectacle. Ryan stayed with the bit, counting the girls down: "One,two...." Then, abruptly yelled "Turnaround!" Driving toward them were TWO Scions! Hysteria ensued, local anchor people rushed in, and the station wound up with a big Scion-eating grin on it's face. Said station promotion consultant, Paige Neinaber, who has been a part of an outrageous radio promotion or two (just don't ask him about giving haircuts on the San Francisco Bay Bridge): "I haven't seen or heard this kind of press coverage ever for a radio contest. It's been insane. Make sure to ask Rob and Paige about it at the Top 40 Format Symposium at the Conclave in a couple of weeks (Friday morning, 7/16, at the Marriott City Center).

Midwest lawmakers were a significant part of what could turn out to be momentous legislation this week, as Senator **Sam Brownback** (R-KS) sponsored an add-on indecency amendment the the Senate's defense bill. The amendment asks to increase maximum indecency fines tenfold to \$275,000. It passed 99-1. Senator **Byron Dorgan** (D-ND) sponsored an additional provision invalidating the FCC's new media ownership rules. It, too passed. The Senate must now vote on the main defense authorization bill to which these amendments have been attached, followed by consideration by a joint House-Senate committee to – ironically – consolidate the two defense bills before it could be sent to the President for a signature or veto.




