KZZQ/Des Moines was knocked off the air this week by a lighting strike. According to PD **Dave St. John**, they were off the air from 11am Wednesday to 4:30pm yesterday (9/16) after the bolt of lightning toasted the main controller board in their transmitter. Unwilling to wait for Fed-Ex, Dave and his weekend jock **Andy** then drove to Harris Broadcast in Quincy, IL (4 1 2 hours away) to pick one up, and they are now comfortably back on-air.

According to a ruling by a Hamilton County Common Pleas court last Thursday (9/9), **Clear Channel** s WSAI/Cincinnati will have to defend itself (in a jury trial) against charges that it is liable for financial losses suffered by victims of a financial scam advertised on the station. **Judge Norbert Nadel** ruled that WSAI must stand trial in a civil lawsuit filed by about (20) individual victims of **George Fiorini**, who pleaded guilty in August to fraud and income tax evasion in connection with a failed \$15 million risk free 10%return promissory note scheme that ran from 1995 to 2001 and was promoted with spots on WSAI featuring a personal endorsement by late local TV and radio legend **Bob Braun**. The station and sister WLW-A promptly pulled the spots in May of 2000 after Fiorini was accused by the state of selling unregistered securities. (Stay tuned for developments!)
