

Conclave Scholarship Season Begins! Soon, the same information will be available inside career counseling offices at high schools around America. This simple application process for the radio industry scholarships involves answering a onepage questionnaire and providing a voice tape/ CD from the prospective student. An essay must accompany the music industry scholarship application in leiu of the audio tape/CD. Details on the Continuing Education Scholarship will be forthcoming in early 2005. The scholarship deadline is April 1, 2005. Winners will be announced shortly thereafter, while the Continuing Education Scholarship winner will be announced during the summer conference. 
