

Changes are afoot on the AM dial in North Dakota as Marine Reservist **Mike McNamara** returns from his year-long stint in Iraq. McNamara was expected to return to KNOX-AM/Grand Forks where **Jarrod Thomas** has been anchoring soldier's spot with a show entitled '*Til Further Notice*. However, the Grand Forks Herald has reported that Thomas' show has been rechristened **JT's World**, prompting speculation as to whether or not McNamara will, indeed, be settling back into his place. Further fueling this idea is the Marine's fill-in status on **Clear Channel** Talk KFGO-AM/Fargo where he is said to be amongst those being considered to step into the space left by **Ed Schultz**' departure for syndication. Meanwhile, after being dropped to make room for Schultz' national show, former KFGO talkers **Jack and Sandy Buttweiler** have moved across town to middays at WDAY-AM.

Ken Lawson, WDBZ/Cincinnati talk show host, is being sued by the grandmother of the victims in Cincinnati's **Stephen Hill** sex abuse case. **Lawson** is Hill's defense attorney. The suit accuses Lawson of using his radio show to criticize both the teenagers who were molested and their grandmother, who is their guardian. The suit says the grandmother suffered humiliation, distress and loss of reputation. The plaintiff seeks unspecified damages from both Lawson and the owner of WDBZ, which airs Lawson's show. As reported in the **Cincinnati Post**, former Cincinnati TV reporter Stephen Hill was accused of engaging "in acts of sexual depravity" against the four teenage boys beginning in March 2001.

Terry "Thayrone" Hughes has found himself in the middle of another radio controversy. Hughes was fired from Public Radio WEMU/Ypsilanti in 2003 when he refused to air NPR newscasts and for his vocal support of the Iraqi war. He is now out of a job again as he exits Clear Channel Triple A WQKL/Ann Arbor. As host of the *Bone Connection* show, Hughes played a song by Unknown Hinson with the lyrics "*Don't try to scream darlin' nobody knows where you are, and they's plenty of oxygen to breathe in the trunk of my Cadillac car"*, this drew the ire of many listeners and a women's group. The host defended himself in the Detroit Free Press saying, "It's a spoof! I also play a song by Gene Watson called, '*I'm Going To Kill You And Bury You In A Box Half Your Size.* It was to no avail, however as Clear Channel lawyer Martha Rose stated that the song was offensive in its glorification of violence against women.
