

A criminal mastermind's machiavellan scheme unraveled in Chicago...when he called into **Clear Channel** WKSC/KISS-FM to brag about his bank robbing escapades. The robbery of a **TCF Bank** in South Chicago last April was still unsolved in the fall when an employee heard someone talking about it on the radio. In a criminal report only made public this week, the **FBI** details how they were able to trace the call to the celphone of one **Randy Washington**. Assistant U.S. Attorney **Terra Brown** said, "We had no leads until one of the individuals in the robbery called 103.5. The details he provided were incredibly helpful in moving this investigation forward." Smart, that one.

Dueling pledge drives? A battle-for-the-contributor is happening in Minneapolis/St. Paul public radio this week, as Minnesota Public Radio's eclectic newcomer, KCMP-FM, and the Minneapolis Public School System's student-run jazz KBEM-FM are both conducting pledge drives. As you know, KCMP signed on last month on the former WCAL frequency (MPR bought WCAL from nearby St. Olaf College, and flipped it from classical). And KBEM had its financial feet yanked out last month when the state legislature dramatically cut its funding as the metro's official **Dept. of Transportation** traffic station (Clear Channel/Minneapolis subsequently came to the rescue with a \$25,000 donation a few weeks ago). Commercial radio has long had individual station battles as a part of its illustrious programming and marketing history, but its far less common for public stations to duke it out in simultaneous fund drives. Steve Nelson, PD of KCMP, said the scheduling was coincidental with all the MPR stations (the classic music station and the news station) conducting their drive together. Kevin Barnes, head of KBEM, also called the happenstance "just one of those things." Echoing Nelson,


Kevin said their drive was put on the calendar last year, without knowledge of when MPR would be running theirs although he admitted KBEM does check with other public stations (like KFAI) to make sure their drives are conducted at different times. He said he doesn't have that same dialogue with MPR. So, those believing the corporate giant (MPR) was making an attempt to compete for funds with the public school station might be creating more of a plot than actually exists. At least, that's their respective stories...and they're sticking to them.

All Spitzer, all the time. Clear Channel, Entercom, Infinity and **Cox** were among the receivers of subpoenas from New York Attorney General Eliot Spitzer earlier this week. His probe of independent record promoters began last fall but so far, he's identified no wrong-doing. However, Entercom and Infinity both fired PDs reputedly in response to the probe. According to a report in RBR/TVBR, a spokesperson for Spitzer indicated his office was trying to build a case that payments and gifts from indies to radio stations or their employees were in violation of New York state statutes on deceptive business practices (although there's a federal law against payola, there's no specific state statute in New York relating to the practice). *Comment: Shortly after receiving their* subpoena, Clear Channel jettisoned the PD of their Chicago GOSPEL (!) station, ostensibly for payola reasons. Wow. If the gospel format is the being scrutinized, we can't wait to see what happens when authorities examine the history of promotional relationships inside the more prolific music formats. While it's true the big dogs of indie promotion have basically left the building, an examination of radio/record promotion activity over the past 3 years - assuming some key invoices possessed by labels hasn't hit the shredder should still provide interesting reading for Mr. Spitzer. And it's no secret he'd like to nail a few programmers AND label exec's on his way to becoming the governor of New York. Like we've been saying, if you added music based on the merit of the song, avoiding the promotional baggage and entrapments behind it...you'll be just fine. If not, it might be time to think about enrolling in that real estate extension class.

KIIC/Osceloa-Lamoni, IA has returned to the airwaves with the calls KOWI. Formerly a country station, KOWI will now be a noncommercial airing **lowa State University's** WOI-AM/ Des Moines.

Interesting **Arbitron** study: Arbitron's *Power of Hispanic Consumers Study 2004-2005* shows that Hispanic consumers are heavier users of radio than newspapers or TV. They spend significantly more time with radio than Non-Hispanics, averaging 22 hours and 30 minutes per week. Hispanic Americans spend half their radio time listening to Spanishlanguage formats. If there's not an Hispanic station operating in your Midwest market, stand by...there will be. If there isn't before you pack up and head for the Conclave Learning

Conference in July, make sure you'll be sitting in the front row for the Hispanic Format Symposium!
