Minneapolis bids farewell to a familiar voice as noontime personality **Derek Moran** departs for Duluth. The **Clear Channel** Top 40 KDWB APD/MD has resigned after 6 plus years with the station. Moran will stick with Clear Channel, however, taking on OM duties for their Duluth Cluster. He'll be handling PD/morning show stuff for Country KKCB, while also working with Hot AC KBMX, Oldies KDLJ and Sports/Talk WEBC-AM. He fills the vacant shoes of **Tommy Bishop**, who left the biz earlier this year.

Multi-tasking got to be too much for **Entercom** Sports KCSP-AM/Kansas City afterooner/ **Kansas City Star** columnist **Jason Whitlock**. The talker up and quit his radio gig on Tuesday (3/1)...while on the air. Whitlock gave the announcement during his opener and one commercial break later, **Doug Franz** was the voice behind the mic. **Entercom**/ Kansas' GM **Michael Keck** spoke to the Star's **Jeffrey Flanagan**, stated

that "...even though he is under contract, Jason and his agent have recently made demands to renegotiate his deal to dramatically increase his compensation, and Entercom was unwilling to meet his demands. As a result, Jason is attempting to tear up his contract rather than live up to the demands he agreed to. Entercom fulfills its contracts and expects those it deals with to do the same." Whitlock also spoke to Flanagan, claiming that more than \$18,500 came out of his own pocket for show promotion. That along with other issues (including the arrival of co-host **Neal Jones** and possible leadership possibilities for himself) prompted the host to approach the station. Whitlock claims his requests were turned down in writing.



Senate Commerce Committee Chairman Ted Stevens (R-AK) is on the move to extend broadcast indecency prohibitions to cable television and satellite radio. Earlier this week, Stevens told the NAB state leadership conference that he will be meeting with representatives of the cable industry next month, threatening them with the following: "I think we can put restrictions on cable" to rid it of "filth." Across the Capitol building, the House is chiming in as House Energy and Commerce Committee Chairman Joe Barton (R-TX) announced he would back a bill in Congress similar to the one proposed by Senator Stevens. "If we can work out the constitutional questions (like, stepping on the First Amendment), I'd be supportive of that...I think they ought to play, to the extent possible, by the same rules." Comment - Anybody else amused by the Stevens/Barton proposals? If a viewer/listener objects to "filth" in something they've willingly bought and brought into their homes/cars and Congress passes a law censoring the "filth" (whatever THAT is) from cable/satellite – then, the next logical target for the purity-seekers of the nation will be printed, purchased PRINTED publications like, say, Playboy: "Y'all, I jest gits the magga-zeen fer the ahrr-tickles but lordyme, I gots to page past them nudie ladies to finish 'em up and I jest shood-dent hafta lay my eyes on THAT! Great gawd-amighty, them dirty foe-toes not only oh-fends me, but it takes me 'nigh onto a good hour to page thru all that FILTH!" Silly? You bet. Eventually, somebody with a sense of American freedom will remind Congress that no one forces the purchaser to turn the sets on, nor does anyone besides the purchaser control their dials. Of course, radio has made the sale of freedom of speech just a bit more difficult by well-published episodes like those of Opie & Anthony's sexcapades or the airing of racially-charged Tsunami songs. But the truth is, those tend to be extreme aberrations on the mostly-entertaining, family-friendly radio and television frequencies.

When over-the-air radio identifies those indiscretions, it generally deals with them quickly. If Congress were REALLY concerned about citizen welfare it might want to prioritize the legislation it proposes a bit differently. For example, this week UNICEF revealed that at least one-fifth of U.S. children live under the national poverty line. Now, THAT'S obscene! – TK
