Organ-izing the 30th Conclave! Most agree that the Conclave has been a professional, life-enhancing experience each summer for the past 30 years. This summer - thanks to the efforts of Aim Strategies' Paul Yeskel and Minnesota LifeSource - the Learning Conference becomes a live-saving event, as well. Neither knew the other would be attending, so the reunion came as a pleasant surprise for both. During a conversation at the Conclave's St. Paul Saints baseball game, Paul shared with John that he had kidney disease and that he would soon die if he could not find a donor kidney. The conversation turned to the difficulty Paul had encountered in finding a donor with his blood type, A+. "Hmmm," said John, "that's mine, too." Over the winter, John gave Paul the gift of life in the form of a new kidney. Says Yeskel, "This summer, John and I will tell our story at the very event which saved my life. We'll urge everyone in attendance to sign up through Minnesota LifeSource to become organ donors." Susan Mau Larson from Minnesota Life Source says, "I'm so excited that Paul and John will be sharing their story in front of the radio and music industries, and that we'll have such an important presence at this incredible event. We'll be passing out awareness kits and we'll have a booth on site throughout the weekend to inform registrants - and their audiences - how they can give the ultimate gift of life through organ donation."

Chicago's National Radio Hall of Fame President Bruce DuMont announced the 2005 nominees this week. 
CONCLAVE RUMOR #1: FCC Commissioner **Jonathan Adelstein**?


