After exploding on to the talk scene, *The Ed Schultz Show* was cleared on 95 stations, 8 of the top 10 markets after only 17 months of syndication. This kind of success is the very reason for the move, as Democracy wants to maintain their status as a place for new talent to find a launching ground. Democracy CEO Tom Athens was quoted saying, "Radio Democracy has accomplished its first mission, now we will return to our core mission, to incubate and launch new progressive voices on America's airwaves." Athens would not comment, however on the rumored major expansion that is to take place for Democracy in 2005, other than a cryptic, "Stay tuned!"

VP of JACK? How's that for a new title? Ask current Infinity/Dallas VP of Programming Kurt Johnson, who will be adding JACK duties to his current job. Infinity president Rob Barnett is excited about the move saying, "As PD of our first JACK station, Kurt has been instrumental in the format's adoption at several Infinity stations across the country. Kurt's first-hand experience will be invaluable to Infinity as we continue to evolve our eight JACK stations." Yes, Kurt will be in the house for the 30th Conclave.

Last week at press time, Infinity put the Jack format on in New York and Chicago to a myriad of opinion. As reported in RBR earlier this week, eyebrows were raised - especially in New York - when the flip went down. Mel Phillips, former Infinity executive with ties to WCBS-FM, had this observation: "You just can't broad-brush the music as everything from the 50s to the 90s. My question is, what kind of music from the 50s to the 90s? I'm sure this is the question both listeners and the advertising community will want answered. You can't just sell the glitz without telling them what's in the glitz. Lite-FM (Clear Channel's WLTW) will be the recipient of this format change, and they'll likely go from a 6+ share to an 8+ share. I don't question the need to change the format but what I do question is a format intended to compete with iPods, mp3s, the Internet and satellite radio. CBS-FM cannot compete with 1,200 titles against 10,000. There is also this: for the most part, every one of those 1,200 songs can be heard on the existing stations in New York, so my final question is this: Why should they listen to you instead of them?" Why, indeed. That question will be explored in its totality at the 30th Annual Learning Conference. Join Edison's Sean Ross at the Billboard Radio Monitor Retro Symposium, as that question and more get analyzed by Sean and guest like Infinity's Jack Director, Kurt Johnson and Howard Kroeger, director of operations and programming for CHUM Broadcasting's Winnipeg stations (and the programmer who invented the Bob format in Canada in 2002 – the format which spawned Jack.)

In spite of the changes, **Charley Lake** will stay on as PD of WJMK online and HD2 digital.
