XM Satellite Radio's recent deal with WCS Wireless is not sitting well with non-satellite broadcasters. Terrestrial radio claims that XM/WCS partnership is in violation of the former's **FCC** license. the terms of which state that XM is to be a national radio service only, and this acquisition would put them at a local/regional level as well. "The proposed transaction is part of a longstanding pattern of deception by the satellite radio industry," said President and CEO of the National Association of Broadcasters, Eddie Fritts, in a letter to Congress sent yesterday (7/14). Fritts also urged legislators to give their support to a bill introduced by House Telecommunications Subcommittee members Chip Pickering (R-Miss.) and **Gene Green** (D-Tex.). The bipartisan bill would put into play legislation that would keep satellite radio companies from placing local content on ground-based repeaters and instruct the FCC to look in to the legal validity of airing local content on channels which are distributed nationally.
