

Big Flip in Minny. Clear Channel's smooth jazz KJZI will morph into FM talk early next year. In January, KTLK FM 100.3 will launch with Rush Limbaugh's live broadcast and then next August, Sean Hannity will also join the station live. Both shows were appropriated from cross-town Hubbard AM talker - KSTP. In a staff memo, Hubbard GM Todd Fisher said the KTLK's launch "does not come as a surprise". He added that the removal of Limbaugh and Hannity "dovetailed with conversations we'd already been having about our future strategies and the state of syndication, particularly the conservative political shows that have shed much of their entertainment value." To what was Todd referring? According to the spring book. Rush Limbaugh's show lost 43 percent of its 25- to 54-year-old audience in the past year and Sean Hannity's show was off 63 percent in the same demo and same time period. As early as last week, Todd told the Minneapolis Star-Tribune "We have really become concerned with what I would call their tight play list of topics revolving around politics. We respect them and they've done well for us, but we're really in a quandary here." Apparently, Clear Channel solved the quandary for Hubbard by plucking the two away from KSTP. The CC plan will be to house Rush and Sean in a stable which will feature live, local, and not-necessarily partisan morning, midday and late afternoon shows. And there may be a longer-term method to CC's madness: the broadcast rights to the Minnesota Twins will be up for grabs soon and it's no secret Clear Channel would love to put them on a local channel of their own. Perhaps the presence of KTLK, coupled with the successful sports-talk KFAN, might make a more attractive package to offer the Twins when they ultimately decide whether to stay with longtime flagship, Infinity's WCCO-AM (CC already holds rights to the Minnesota Vikings). Stay tuned.

Radio across the Midwest and America have taken to fund-raising for the victims of the horrific Katrina. We'll put a few stories in the *TATTLER* (space permitting) about how stations are responding. We'll share this bit of advice from **New World Communication's** promotion guru, **Paige Neinaber**, about collecting items for personal, station delivery to the hurricane-ravaged communities for maximum public exposure and participation: "Where do you go? Drive. Find a town. Pull up and start handing it out. It's that simple. Don't over-think this. Like with 'Charlie' you might have some paperwork to fill out. Just do NOT give this to the Red Cross. AND make sure you do it live on the air." *TATTLER* note: Certainly, if your station *cannot* drive to the cities/counties in need you can (and should) deliver your collected goods to

the **Red Cross**, **Salvation Army** or any other recognized national assistance organization. The bottom line for any and all support your station will be giving the Katrina victim recovery effort is to assist human beings in need. Once that primary goal is being accomplished, you can let your community know what you're doing/did.

This morning, **Entercom/Indianapolis**' News Talk 1430 WXNT-AM and Z99.5 hosted a joint "Drive-Thru Donation" campaign to raise money for the **Salvation Army** Disaster Relief Efforts in Gulf States hit by Hurricane Katrina. Listeners were asked to drive by one of their pre-announced locations and drop off cash, or checks. Representatives from the Salvation Army were on hand at all locations throughout the day to help. The stations also included a link for online credit card donations on all of its websites.

Saga's WSNY/Columbus morning duo **Dino & Stacy** are conducting a 30-hour radiothon to raise funds for the Red Cross relief effort. The station's entire staff will man the phones to take donations.

The **Infinity**/Kansas City cluster (Top 40 KMCV, AC KSRC, Country KBEQ) has teamed up with area grocer **Price Chopper** to fill four Uhauls with over70,000 bottles of water to be driven down to **Hurricane Katrina** victims.

Conclave regulars and nationally-syndicated morning show "Bob & Sheri" announced details of a fundraising campaign to benefit the victims of Hurricane Katrina. Hosts Bob Lacey and Sheri Lynch made the announcement throughout their broadcast this morning. The effort, "Beads for the Bayou," will allow listeners to make a cash donation to the Hurricane Katrina relief effort in exchange for Mardi Gras beads. All monetary proceeds to the "Beads for the Bayou" campaign will be donated to the American Red Cross. The campaign will be open to participation for all Bob & Sheri affiliates nationwide. Listeners from across the country will be able to log on to the official Bob & Sheri website, www.bobandsheri.com, to check their local markets for more specific details and donation locations.

It looks like 2005 Conclave Keynoter **Mancow Muller** will be staying put at **Emmis** Alternative WKQX/Chicago. Rumors had been circulating about the irreverent morning man's possible relocation to **Infinity** Talk WCKG as a replacement for the satellite-bound **Howard Stern**. In the **Chicago Sun-Times**, WCKG **VP/GM Marv Nyren** was reported as giving credence to the fact that at one point the move was a possibility, but the current situation has Muller sticking with Emmis. No Stern replacement is, as of yet, seen on the horizon.

Clear Channel AAA KTCZ/Minneapolis-St. Paul PD Lauren Macleash has been named National Adult Album Alternative Liaison/Director. While maintaining her duties at KTCZ, Macleash will now be at the helm of development and programming for all of Clear Channel's AAA stations. She'll be partnering with artists and labels as well in order to put together marketing opportunities. Macleash has a rich radio history that spans over a decade in the AAA format, most of it right at KTCZ!





The 2005 Radio Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony will take place in Chicago on November 5, and will be MC'd by Regis Philbin. Amongst those being inducted are famed comedy team Abbott & Costello, Voice of the Cincinnati Reds Marty Brennaman and ABC News correspondent Ann Compton.


