Nominations aren't the only thing making headlines for CMA. An article in Thursday's (9/8) edition of *The Tennessean* brought into question CMA's decision to move the awards location to New York City's Madison Square Garden. Staff writer Peter Cooper brings to light Big Apple residents' confusion as to why the event is being held in a city home to exactly zero Country radio stations. One confused New Yorker said, "...I can't think of anyone at all who listens to country. That's why I'm surprised to find out they're going to have the awards up here." To CMA Executive Director **Ed Benson**, this attitude is exactly the point, "This evidences the reason we're here. The media in New York is incredible...more than we'd get back in Nashville." This media was on hand to capture the scene in Union Square Park later that day as 2005 Conclave performer **Cowboy Troy** to the stage in his uniform of cowboy hat and belt buckle the size of a few metro cards. Surrounding him? Hay bales. It's remains a mystery to many why the Nashville music association establishment – when they want to do country presentations like award shows outside of Tennessee - travel to places like New York or Los Angeles. When was the last major national country music event held in the heartland cities of Minneapolis, Kansas City, or Milwaukee...where country radio is not only present, but has been known to dominate?
