As reported in last week's edition of the *TATTLER*, Clear Channel KEFM/Omaha got in to the holiday spirit early, flipping briefly to an All-Christmas format, but it was just a stunt used to their re-launch as Rock KQBW! The new playlist, which debuted Friday (9/23), borrows liberally from the group's successful "Brew" format in Milwaukee – meaning, it consists of 80's powerhouse bands **Def Leppard** and **AC/DC** as well as the occasional foray into the more contemporary. The station is currently broadcasting commercial free from their 5,000-song library. Along with new calls, the station, and the cluster at large, has made some modifications to their staff. Mornings for KWBW will consist of the **Michelle & Mooky** team as well as new co-host from sister Country KXKT: middayer **Kevin Kannon**. The midday hole at KXKT will be filled by Classic Country KHUS' afternoon driver **Ritch Cassidy**. Finally, **Dan Roberts** leaves middays at KHUS to take on Cassidy's drive time.

Formats were also flipping in Chicago as **ABC** Active Rock WZZN (The Zone) made the switch to **94.7 Chicago's True Oldies Station**. Listeners will now hear everything from the hits of **Elvis Presley** and **The Beach Boys** to the classic sounds of Motown. WZZN GM **Jim Pastor** says that this won't be a typical Oldies format because of its "deep playlist and current sound". Local news, weather, traffic and sports will augment programming during mornings and afternoon drive time. Taking leave of the new format are former PD **Bill Gamble**, APD/MD **James Vanosdol** and the entirety of The Zone's airstaff.







The search continues for **Howard Stern's** replacement at WCKG/Chicago. Continuing coverage by **Chicago Sun-Times' Robert Feder** is now reporting that **Eddie and JoBo** of sister WBBM may be given a try-out at all-talk mornings on Sports WSCR. They are far from the only rumored Stern-alternative, as the erstwhile **Garry Meier's** name has also come up and he had a chance to be heard on KLSX/Los Angeles last weekend with a few different co-hosts. Meier would come with baggage however; he was at one time a co-host of WCKG afternoons with current host **Steve Dahl**. But the two parted on bad terms. Meier also left afternoons at WLS/Chicago last year after a salary dispute.

Conclave XXX Keynoter Jonathan Adelstein continues to make clear the importance of the public's say in the revision of ownership rules for the FCC. The FCC Commissioner was in Philadelphia earlier this week (9/28) for a media consolidation forum where, in addition to the ownership issue, he made remarks similar to those he made the NAB Radio Show on 9/22, reiterating the necessity to "do something about" payola. These comments come in the wake of Eliot Spitzer's Sony BMG investigation/settlement.

Clear Channel has promoted Jeff Hoberg from GM/Grand Forks to VP/Market Manager for the seven stations in the company's Fargo cluster. Hoberg had been in the GM slot since 1999. Also in Fargo, Classic Rock KKBX has flipped to 80's and taken **Premiere's Bob & Tom** show from sister Rock KDAM for mornings.

Tom Gjerdrum is back; the former OM/PD at WMYX/Milwaukee, WI is now handling OM duties for the **Backyard Broadcasting**/Sioux Falls cluster. In addition he's taken on mornings for AC KELO as **Tom Mitchell.**



Envision's *AudioXchange* prep service is now offering audio clips and sound bites formatted for JACK-FM[™] stations. Produced by the writers from BitXchange, the clips provide stations with pop culture audio for promos, sweepers, etc.

Radio One has agreed to purchase Adult Standards WRDA/St. Louis from **Emmis** for \$20 million. The stations' current "Red" format will make the transition to the web and weekends on sister Talk KFTK as Radio One takes on WRDA under an LMA effective October 1.
