FCC Commissioner and 2005 Conclave XXX Keynoter Jonathan Adelstein continues, to voice his strong opinions regarding ownership restrictions, just as he did on the Learning Conference stage in July. He spoke Wednesday (10/5) at the University of Iowa's Town Meeting on the Future of Radio. "You can't put the toothpaste back in the tube," Adelstein said, according to the Des Moines Register. KZIA/Cedar Rapids had its GM, Eliot Keller, on hand and he noted that his was the last station standing not owned by Clear Channel or Cumulus in the Cedar Rapids-Iowa City market. Said Keller, "I hope the FCC doesn't allow local ownership to go the way of the dinosaur." While he was in the Hawkeye state, Adelstein also wrote an editorial for the Iowa City Press-Citizen, published earlier this week. While the FCC is holding official open hearings on the matter, Adelstein and fellow Commissioner Michael Copps have been attending a variety of forums similar to this one all across the country because, as Adelstein puts it, "the best jury is the American people. You can't wait to see what they think if you sit in Washington and wait for the lobbyist to come tell us what to think." The sharp tongued Adelstein has been outspoken in his feelings regarding the FCC's practices in this area, calling his own commission at "toothless tiger" that was of no help in stemming the tide of ownership concentration.

In light of their syndication, **Lex and Terry** have moved from **Cox** to **Clear Channel**, with their show now broadcasting from the **Port St. Lucie** studios of WZZR/West Palm Beach-Fort Pierce. This will be in effect while they wait out a 120-day non-compete to air again in Jacksonville. Longtime Dir./ Syndication **Peter Welpton** and the rest of the L&T crew will make the transition along with the show. The new deal will have the show airing on both Clear Channel and non CC stations. One half of the due, **Lex Staley**, commented, "The Lex Terry radio network and Clear Channel relationship is a win-win situation on the syndication level...(it) makes great business sense for both parties." Seems an **XM** satellite deal may also be in the works.

Another **Conclave XXX Keynoter** making the news is **TRN**'s **Mancow Muller**, as the morning maven adds three more affiliates: **Clear Channel** Rock KRZR/Fresno, **Journal** Rock KZRQ/Springfield and **Union** Rock KZPL/Kansans City. This brings the **Emmis** Alternative WKQX/Chicago-based Muller's affiliate numbers to over two dozen, including huge markets like KLAC/Los Angeles.



Midwest Congresswoman slams Bennett! Rep. Stephanie Tubbs Jones (D-OH) is calling for the removal of former Secretary of Education William Bennett from his syndicated talk-show after his statement on abortion, crime and African Americans. "I am outraged and appalled at William Bennett's recent comments suggesting the aborting of black babies would reduce the crime rate in this country," she said "His comments were deplorable and undeniably racist. Mr. Bennett owes this nation an apology and I expect the FCC to take swift action in removing his show from the air." TATTLER COMMENT: Let's get Bennett together with Pat Robertson as talk-show co-hosts and REALLY test the FCC's mettle...oh, wait...never mind. The FCC only handles complaints which deal with wanton remarks by the likes of Mancow and Howard Stern about body parts. On air racism and war-mongering are just fine, thank you.

Good news/Bad news from the Music Industry. The Good news - The International Federation of the Phonographic Industry (IFPI) said digital music sale revenues tripled in the first half of 2005 compared with 2004. The organization said 6% of record industry sales were digital, which nets out to a worth of \$790 million. "The digital music boom is continuing and it is growing at an exciting pace for the music industry," IFPI said. The growth of digital sales was being driven by the increased use of broadband, 3G mobile phones and portable music players. Now for the Bad news: sales of CDs fell 6.3% and the overall market by 1.9%. That means CDs experienced a global drop from 13.4 billion to 13.2 billion for all music sales - regardless of format. By country: US-5.3% drop in value; Japan-9.2% drop in value; UK - 4% drop in value; Germany -5.8% drop in value; France - 2.7% drop in value. TATTLER *COMMENT:* the music industry had better start figuring this out, or there won't be any new music left for digital to sell. And here's a generous hint: the answer ISN'T going to be found in suing downloaders.

The AM trio is made up of former WTUE/Dayton, OH jock Steve Kerrigan and WMEE midday vet Chris Cage and WMEE staffer Erika Taylor...Tracey Garrett goes full time as APD/MD/middayer, up from the interim role at Clear Channel Country KZSN/ Wichita...Dan Fullick is leaving his Virgin Record spot in Chicago for one in New York City. Allison Smith of Lava will fill his shoes.

**Radio Disney** WFDF-A/Flint, MI is movin' on up, to Detroit, that is! On the way there, the station will update their signal with a 50,000-watt daytime signal and a new 18,000-watt night signal expected to be approved by the **FCC** before the end of the month.

Feller Adult Standards KSQB/Sioux Falls, SD will flip back to Sports on Monday (10/10). The Station will function as 1520 *The Score* with programming including Fox Sports, Jim Rome of Premiere and Clear Channel/Minneapolis' K-FAN network. This will make KSQB the second Sports format in the market, joining Backyard Broadcasting's KWSN.

Waitt/Omaha and Commonwealth Radio have signed an exclusive arrangement to syndicate the Jack-ish *BOB-FM* format, which the press release describes as "playing all styles of music on one station." Consulting will be Joel Folger of Folger Entertainment; Waitt will be offering the format with localized content for affiliates.

Andrew "Big Z" Zepada, of Journal Hot AC KZPT/Tucson, heads back to the Midwest for a morning co-host spot alongside Micki at Clear Channel Top 40 WVKS/Toledo. Zepada spent time doing wake ups at Citadel Top 40 WIOG/ Saginaw before his stint in Arizona. He'll replace WVKS jock Johnny D who's moved crosstown to Cumulus T40 WTWR.

Kevin Arvidson exists his AM OM slot at Leighton Broadcasting/Grand Forks, ND as well as his talk spot on KNOX. The Grand Forks Herald cites "differing management philosophies" as the reason for the parting of ways. Arvidson's exit comes on the heels of the departure of another KNOX host Dakota Huseby.


WTMX/Chicago is planning a new, nightly on-air dating game airing weeknights from 7 to 9PM. The hosts for the Hot AC's program will be **Jeff Corder** and **Nikki Chuminatto**. The show



will be called *Mix 'N Match*, a show in which singles can choose from among three potential dates...ala *The Dating Game*. Said Mix PD **Mary Ellen Kachinske**, "Time and time again listeners have told us that the dating scene is one of the most frustrating things that they have to deal with, so everyone at the Mix is excited to offer this new concept, have some fun on the air and maybe even hook a few people up with their dream date."

Radio Business Report asked an interesting question of its subscribers this week. Because the NAB has announced plans to co-locate their September 2006 convention with the R&R convention, RBR wondered - which would be best for radio? The results: Colocating NAB & R&R -16%, Colocating NAB & RAB -24%, Combining the NAB Radio Show with the NAB Las Vegas covention -22%, a pure Radio Industry convention completely apart from the NAB with focus thinking 37%. *TATTLER COMMENT:* looks like a majority of the RBR respondents will be coming to the Conclave's summer Learning Conference – **PURE RADIO 2006** - next July (check out <u>www.theconclave.com</u> for details)!
