Clear Channel issued a press release on Tuesday (10/11) in regard to the termination of two employees naming "inappropriate conduct" as the reason behind the lay-off. No one, however, could have predicted the following day's memo from Sr. VP/Programming Tom Poleman in stating that WWPR/New York PD Michael Sanders was no longer with Clear Channel, effective immediately and wishing him "the very best in future endeavors". The memo went on to name VP/Urban Programming (and Conclave XXX Faculty member) Doc Wynter as the interim. Not long after this surprising pronouncement, Diana Laird, PD for KHTS/San Diego, was ousted. There was no replacement named.

Even sleep deprived opponents couldn't save the White Sox from defeat on Tuesday (10/11), and if you think the players were disappointed imagine how Infinity Talk WCKG/Chicago staffers Ryan "mender" Mendenhall and Cark Klockers felt; the two were arrested earlier that day for attempting to rouse Sox opponents the Anaheim Angels from their slumber at a nearby hotel.

Also in trouble with the law, former WRYV/Gallipolis, OH OM/jock **Steve "Rhino" Reinhardt**, who has been sentenced to a two-year prison term. He was convicted of stalking an unnamed 22-year old woman and entering her family home in order to steal her underwear, which he later left soiled in the victim's car. Reinhardt will also be required to apologize to the woman and her family.
