

Over 60 A.T.W.A.F.'s (Air Talent With A Future) and professional programmers flocked to Cleveland's Holiday Inn Select last weekend for the 10th TalenTrak - the Conclave's intensive, one-day air talent improvement seminar. The first morning session, HOW NOT TO GET A JOB, was moderated by **Daniel Anstandig/McVay Media**, with the faculty help of **Don Hallett-WVMX/Cleveland**, Tom Cook-WSNI/Philadelphia and Kasper-Kiss/Cleveland. They spoke of how they got into radio and how their different career paths lead them to their current stations. They emphasized the importance of networking, and how persistence and knowing where they wanted to go at each level of their career gave them clear goals. They shared that they see promising new talent thankfully coming into the business, and candidly expressed what a resume and aircheck should include. They concluded their hour with tips about how a person should prepare to get their foot in the door, and how to excel once a talent has been given a job. The second session, AND NOW FOR SOMETHING COMPLETELY DIFFERENT, was hosted by Mark **Anderson** who represented both Clear Channel/Pittsburgh and the Audience Development group. He was joined on stage by 3 air talents: Scotty-Kiss/Pittsburgh, Alan Cox-WXDX/Pittsburgh and Christy Cantle-WMMS/Cleveland. They revealed the importance of individuality and having the courage to be different - even though management may be pushing in a different direction. They discussed the importance of earning the trust of a PD in order to gain the freedom to be themselves on the air. Each talked about the difficulties encountered in the process and how to overcome them. They also shared the brutal truth- that a truly unique air talent should be prepared to move around until they find

that right situation for them. The morning was capped by WLS/Chicago PD Kipper McGee and HOW BIG IS THIS THING GONNA GET. In this hour, Kipper talked about how each person should act as the CEO of their own life, stressing how essential personal marketing is for everybody in the biz. Says Kipper, "There are many undiscovered geniuses...but very few undiscovered marketers"! Kipper revealed the 9 secrets to success, and used a illuminating illustration of a triangle describing the 3 phases of everyone's career: Phase 1 would represent the wide end of the triangle, where a person discovers what they want to do; Phase 2 is represented by the middle section, where an individual finds focus by preparing themselves for greatness; and Phase 3 - the tip of the triangle - is where the individual focuses on peak performance. After the morning sessions, the TalenTrak student body and faculty adjourned for lunch and a keynote presentation by syndicated morning talent (and Xtreme/Cleveland air talent), Rover. He regaled the crowd with stories of his career from how he started out by faking a resume and getting busted with it in a PD's office (current Chicago programmer, Mike Stern, who did the busting at Extreme/Las Vegas) to all his current trials and tribulations as a syndicated morning man who "moonlights" as a full-time air talent in Cleveland. He shared interesting "do's" and "dont's" which have helped him along the way - like how a person should properly package and present themselves to prospective employers, and how networking and generating positive press have helped further his career. The afternoon was devoted to 3 hours of invaluable individual on-air critiques provided by more than 2 dozen programming professionals during TalenTrak's characteristic Aircheck Clinic, followed by the always unpredictable and entertaining WAR STORIES session.

The event was coordinated by WLUP/Chicago's Bill Klaproth (who acted as the day's emcee), along with Elyria-Lorain Broadcasting's Tim Kelly, Envision's Danno Wolkoff, Provident Insurance's Dave Hintz, WCOW/Sparta-LaCrosse's Bob Goff, and Daniel Anstandig. TalenTrak 2005 was presented by Platinum partners BDS Radio/Nielsen Entertainment, BitXChange/AudioXChange, PromoSuite/ListenerEmail, Telos-Omnia Axia, and Gold partners Envision Radio Networks and XRadioNetworks/Jefferson-Pilot.

As the TATTLER hinted last week, former WDRQ/Detroit PD Alex Tear was named today as the new PD of Clear Channel CHR WKST/Pittsburgh. He replaces Mark **Anderson**, who now heads to Las Vegas as the newest member of Tim Moore's Audience Development Group.

Conspiracy theories aren't limited to right-wing talkers, as evidenced by Fargo-based Liberal radio talk show host Ed Schultz's reaction to the news that his Armed Forces Radio debut was cancelled before he even got on the air after his producer got word from Allison Barber, the Pentagon's deputy assistant secretary for internal communications. Schultz wondered about the timing of the decision, pointing to the fact that he spent the end of last week criticizing Barber for coaching a group of US soldiers in Iraq before a teleconference with **President Bush**. Schultz said, "It kind of floored us. The fact is, they don't want dissenting voices or any other kind of speech unless it's going to be promotional for them. Obviously, these people are making sure they're not going to have any opinion other than the Rush Limbaughs of the world."

ABC WDRQ morning man Jay Towers is heading crosstown to fill middays at Infinity Talk WKRK/Detroit. He'll co-host with Michelle McKormic. Heard in mornings on WDRQ during both its top 40 and "Doug-FM" incarnations, Towers negotiated a severance with ABC Radio before signing a multi-year deal with Infinity. Towers replaces Gregg Henson who was dismissed last week, following an Infinity review into disparaging comments he made about crosstown WKQI night host Tic Tak.

Infinity Country WYCD/Detroit has appointed Tim Roberts as Program Director. Roberts joins the station from **Cumulus** where he held the position of Midwest Regional Operations Manager overseeing radio stations in Youngstown, Toledo, Western Pennsylvania, and Southern Michigan.

Clear Channel Hot AC WVTI/Grand Rapids has flipped to Adult Hits WMAX (calls pending FCC approval) and will be

featuring a playlist of nearly 2000 songs. They kicked off the new format with **Bruce Springsteen's** "Dancing In The Dark". Doug Montgomery, Dir./FM Operations/Grand Rapids, will be in charge of programming in place of WVTI's Brian Casey. No jocks were named as of this writing, and if the station holds true to 'jack' form, don't expect any to come on board for a while.

From *Tattler* Medical correspondent, **Dr. Turner** Heddencoff: Ahh, October, a month filled with fall colors, brisk weather, trick-or-treaters and....prostate exams? It is if you're a **Bob & Tom** listener! The **Premiere** duo has dubbed it **Proctober** and is using their wide syndication to support the National Prostate Cancer Coalition's "Drive Against Prostate Cancer" a service that offers free and confidential exams to men all over America. The show's Sports Dir. Chick McGee got an exam live on the air on the NPCC's mobile unit to promote the drive.

The CMA has elected Capitol/Nashville President/CEO Mike Dungan as the new President of the Board of Directors for the term beginning November 16th while former President Victor Sansone was elected Chairman of the Board. Dungan said, "Personally, I am both awed and challenged. Just the thought of following in their (Sansone and other former President Kix) footsteps is a bit overwhelming." Mike's a former Minneapolis RCA promotion rep, and was a key player in bringing superstar Keith Urban to last summer's Conclave Learning Conference.

Infinity Country WUBE/Cincinnati morning man Bill Whyte has released an album entitled "Off The Wall", full of original comedy-songs. Whyte recorded at Bluebird Café in Nashville. A CD release party is planned for Nov. 8th at the Funnybone in Cinci featuring Whyte along with artists Linda Davis and Lisa Shaffer (new on Lyric Street).

Steve Moore has been promoted from Dir/Programming & Operations at Infinity Talk KMOX/St. Louis to VP/News-Talk. This comes only two years after being named PD at KMOX.



Dave Ryan will be tacking on at least three more years to his current twelve at **Clear Channel** Top 40 KDWB/Minneapolis, as the morning star has just signed a new contract.

Ken Cocker will be the new morning man at **Infinity** AC WLTE/Minneapolis joining co-host **Cindy Barton**. Cocker's two decades of radio experience have seen him criss-cross the country from Indiana to Georgia with his last gig doing mornings for AC WPNT- Country WUSN/Chicago.

Take That Big Screen And Shove It Dept: The *New York Times* reports that on Tuesday (10/18), Indie label **TSR Records** filed a lawsuit against **Sony BMG** in the **Los Angeles Federal District Court**. The suit accuses the major label of "unfairly dominating radio play lists through the use of bribes to programmers and other illicit tactics.". The smaller label is claiming that Sony has violated federal



and California anti-trust laws, therefore interfering with the former's business prospects by preventing their artists from having a presence on radio. The suit, which seeks unspecified monetary damages and attorneys' fees, was filed by TSR some three months after Sony BMG settled the highly publicized payola case brought against it by New York Attorney General **Eliot Spitzer**.

ABC's hit feel-good reality show "Extreme Makeover: Home Edition" cast member **Eduardo Xol** recently invited **Journal** Country KFDI/Wichita morning star **Dan Tooker** to broadcast live from their set. Xol got the idea after hearing the "Tooker in the Morning" show. Tooker reports that in the time that he did his 4-hour show, they constructed a two-story house!

Condolences to **Clear Channel** Talk WISN-AM/Milwaukee host **Jay Weber** on the death of his mother **Mary Jane Weber**, 63, in an automobile accident Friday (10/14) in Brookfield, WI.

It seems that even though he avoided being owner during the latest Minnesota "The Love Boat" Vikings scandal, trouble is following Clear Channel co-founder B.J. "Red' McCombs and his partner Gary V. Woods are battling the IRS over two partnerships ruled a shams. Forbes Magazine has reported that the ruling has prevented McCombs from writing off a \$34.1 million loss from currency trading and Woods from reporting an \$11.4 million loss. The latter has already filed suit against the IRS, but McCombs has not yet filed a suit. MCCOMBS and Lowry Mays founded Clear Channel (then San Antonio Broadcasting Co.) in 1972; McCombs remains a member of the company's Board of Director

Could **Emmis** be going private? That's the rumor being floated on **IBJ.com** who have speculated about CEO **Jeff Smulyan** taking the company stock off the market. The exec said when questioned that, "Everything is under consideration. There is nothing that's not under consideration." Smulyan himself currently has 15% share ownership and 62% voting control. Emmis went public twice, in 1994 and in 1999.
