

Marc Kalman stepped in to his new role as President/GM for ABC/Minneapolis on Wednesday, November 9. He comes to the position from a similar role at Clear Channel/Minneapolis. Kalman will be at the helm of several stations, including Classic Rock force KQRS, Active Rock WXXR and Alternative WGVX-WGVY-WGVZ. He's replacing the recently departed Amy Rosenthal. Of the new hire, ABC radio President Mitch Dolan said, "Marc's proven expertise and his local market insight made him the ideal choice to lead ABC Radio's radio properties in the Twin Cities." Marc began his Twin Cities radio odyssey as an AE at WCCO-AM, moving to KDWB as GM (later adding KTCZ to his management resume), and most recently worked for Hubbard's KS95 as bossman.

Regis Philbin hosted at the National Radio Hall of Fame ceremony last Saturday (11/5) where new inductees were announced. Among those honored were celebrated comedic duo Abbot & Costello, sports guy Marty Brennaman, special correspondent to the White House Ann Compton, football commentator Myron Cope and humorist Jean Shepherd. The show was produced by Westwood One and broadcast from the Renaissance Chicago Hotel.

When tornadoes ravaged Illinois towns Newburgh and Evansville last Sunday (11/6), they forged a path of destruction that left fatalities and injuries in their wake. Damage was also sustained at the **Dielectric Towers** in Newburgh. Crosstown at the South Central/Evansville cluster, they were more fortunate with their **Electronics Research** tower/antennae, so the Top 40 WSTO morning team of **Booker & Sarah** came in to the station and reported live emergency information including the locations of shelters and supplies.


No news yet for **Emmis' Jeff Smulyan** and his group on whether or not they will be the new owners of the **Washington Nationals**. Major League Baseball commissioner **Bud Selig** has announced that no vote will take place on the issue at next week's owner's meeting in Milwaukee, WI. Selig says he has interviewed representatives from five of the bidders and the others "certainly deserve one interview... I have three to go, and I'm trying to do those as quickly as possible."

KLIK/Jefferson City, MO talker **James Keown** stands accused of murdering his wife, but maintains his innocence. Known on the air as **JP O'Neill**, **Keown** was taken in to custody on Monday (11/7) and he is accused of slowly poisoning his wife with antifreeze. Keown's attorney **Adam A. Kretowicz** told the Associated Press' **Denise Levoie** that his client "absolutely denies that he had any involvement in her death. They were deeply in love with each other... He has no information as to how this occurred."

A drive-by shooting in Port Orange, FL on Saturday (11/5) killed former shock jock **Dale (Richards) Allenbaugh.** He had been working as a DJ at a local night club on the evening of the shootings, and had ejected several patrons. It is thought by authorities that those are the men responsible for the shooting. Allenbaugh spent time at stations from WRQK/Canton to WZJM/Clevland. He was the don of **Dave "Bobby Knight" Allenbaugh** who is a DJ in New Smyrna, FL and has had stints at such stations at WHLO, WCUE, WKDD, and several Cleveland stations.

Ed Schultz will join the American Forces Radio after all. Originally the Fargo-based Jones-syndicated talker was denied clearance in a last minute controversy regarding comments Schultz had made about a teleconference between a group of soldiers and President Bush being "staged". Seems the Pentagon has changed its mind, however and the show will go on.

KDLS/Perry, IA flipped to Spanish when purchased by the Latin Broadcasting Corp., leaving the market bereft of English-language programming. The Des-Moines Register is now reporting that an area businessman Bob Boyle is attempting to pool cash to buy the AM incarnation of the KDLS signal. So far he's raised about \$40, 000.00 with a goal of about \$300,000.

Exhilarating news was heard by Country a few weeks ago when MCA recording artist Lee Ann Womack called the 2005 CMA Broadcast Awards winners on-air to personally deliver the exciting news. The CMA Broadcast Personality of the Year, including National Broadcast Personality of the Year and CMA Radio Station of the Year recipients will be recognized during the "The 39th Annual CMA Awards," next Tuesday, Nov. 15 (8:00-11:00 PM/ET) live on the CBS Television Network from Madison Square Garden in New York City. Womack, who is nominated for six CMA Awards in 2005, called the CMA Broadcast Personality and CMA Radio Station of the Year winners on the stations' studio hotlines. That meant she made calls to a couple of Midwest locations, including country K102/Minneapolis to tell them they were the 2005 Major Market Radio award winner! It marked the very first CMA Award for the **Clear Channel** outlet. "This is really one of the greatest moments in the history of K102. Just to be mentioned with other legendary stations in our category was a thrill," said OM Gregg Swedberg of KEEY. "This will keep us warm all winter long!" Other regional winners included WUSN/ Chicago's Lisa Dent, who takes home Major Market Personality Of The Year honors and KSSN/Little Rock, which won CMA's Medium Market Station Of The Year award.
