

Former Top 40 WNOU/Indianapolis morning man **Dennis** "Billy Breeze" Grubbs and the station's owner Emmis have settled in a suit brought against both of them by Grubbs' former girlfriend Bonnie Jean Ventress. Charges were originally brought when the radio jock allegedly broadcast Ventress' personal cell phone number during his morning show after their breakup. He offered a prize to the listener who could harass her most. The suit alleged that several death threats were made. Details of the case have not been released. The ironic new job for Grubbs? Afternoons on Contemporary Christian WAYF/West Palm Beach, under the name Randy Haze.

By the time your read this, **Disney** may have sold **ABC Radio** to **Citadel** for a reputed \$3 billion. *The New York Times* earlier this week said that Disney rejected **Kohlberg Kravis Roberts** and **Entercom** to go into exclusive negotiations with Citadel.

During construction on the new **Bott Broadcasting** KBCV/Hollister, MO tower, a bulldozer clipped a cable, killing **Michael Wilerson** of Lawson, OK when the accident toppled the tower. Condolences to family and friends on the loss.

Shawn Stewart is promoted from APD/MD/middays to PD for **Entercom** AAA KMTT/Seattle; she'll be replacing **Chris Mays** who left for a PD spot at **CBS** Hot AC KLLC/ San Francisco. Shawn spent time at Rev 105 in Minneapolis before moving on to Seattle.

A most interesting move was made by **Cumulus** earlier this week, as it announced it would no longer allow its music stations to report adds to the trades. And all nonmonitored Cumulus stations will no longer submit their playlists to the trades, effectively ending their reporting status to publications such as Radio & Records, R&R's Editor **Kevin Carter** posed the question "why" to Cumulus EVP John Dickey, who explained, "I just couldn't think of a good reason why we did it. Our PDs, depending on format, are charged with being innovative and aggressive locally in the markets we program to, and I still don't think the reporting of adds encourages that local process...To some extent, the process became so confining because programmers were limited to whatever the label gives us every week, which I felt led to some unfortunate consequences...Adds were running up and down the chart very quickly to make room for 2-3 more songs next week. Programmers were encouraged to move songs quickly through the system because that's the way it has always been done. From our perspective, that system is not in the best interest of our brands — our listeners expect more from us; they expect us to be more circumspect with regard to new music, and that's why we're no longer going to participate." Some speculated out loud that the Cumulus initiative may have been prompted by a combination of the on-going Elliott **Spitzer** investigation coupled with Cumulus' expected receipt of it's newly purchased Susquehanna properties sometime next month. All this makes the other announcement coming out of Cumulus this week – that Cumulus' indie. **John Kilgo**. is now on staff at Cumulus Media to develop business models for the company's dealings with record labels – even more intriguing.

CBS T40 KMXV/Kansas City names Dave Johnson as MD, replacing Joe Mack(hothtz@aol.com or 913-961-0816). Johnson is also APD/MD/Morning co-host for sister Hot AC KSRC. Could it be that "Just Plain Dave" may take on Taylor's PD duties? Johnson isn't saying yes, but he's not saying no! He did tell All Access "KSRC changed call letters last night at midnight to KCKC. The station is still HOT AC for now." What other changes may be in store for the KC CBS cluster? Stay tuned!





Colleen Kuczinski was ecstatic when she and her 1986 Chevy S10 truck were named the winners in Clear Channel Top 40 WKST/Pittsburgh's "Freak My Ride" contest; she had visions of "a new paint job and new audio, something (she) could let (her) son drive", but the results were not what she'd expected so she's suing the station. Local Greenwald Automotive owner David Greenwald and his crew spent long hours overhauling the cars of five winners, "freaking" Kuczincski's with a copper-speckled yellow paint job, hooked up an air-ride suspension and installed a stereo and entertainment system in the bed, complete with a TV, barbecue and cooler....but with an unexpected twist: The winner wasn't able to drive it home. "It's beautiful, but not drivable," said Kuczinski, "the frame was cut. It was held together with speaker wires...At first I wanted to enter it into car

shows and get recognition for Greenwald's, now my goal

is to have a street-legal truck that I can drive." Clear

Channel had no comment on pending litigation.

Bonneville AC WILV/Chicago welcomes radio vet Ric Lippincott on board to fill the PD shoes left vacant by David J. This marks a return to radio for Lippincott who's most recent gig was as a principal in the All Comedy Network; before that, he was VP/Promotions at Curb Records and Zoo Entertainment. He's no stranger to PD duties thought as he was OM/PD for ABC's WLS during its Top 40 heyday and also doing the PD honors for T40 WYTZ. In his spare time he's also managed to get his commercial pilot license. Lippincott has some changes in store for the station, according to the Chicago Sun-Times Robert Feder, including a focus on "more high energy 'feel good' songs."

Clear Channel/Toledo OM Bill Michaels welcomes Aaron Roberts on as PD for Rocker WIOT saying, "Aaron has done a great job with his station [WROV/Roanoke] and is ready for the challenges that WIOT will bring. [He] understands our mission and is looking forward to the ratings and revenue potential that WIOT will bring." They key to Aaron's success? Could one reason be that he was the 1991 Conclave Scholarship winner?

Midwest Communications has purchased a four-station Kalamazoo cluster from Fairfield Broadcasting for \$13.25 million. The stations are: AC WQLR, Talk WKLZ, Sports WQSN, and Talk WKZO. Steve Trivers will consult for the next five years. In a statement to the Kalamazoo Gazette, Fairfield's Bill Wertz was quoted saying, "We are the last truly locally owned day-operated media in Kalamazoo. That officially will end, but- and it's a huge but- Midwest is here and has been here for several years."

Middays, meanwhile, go to Karen Foxx who doesn't have to travel far from her former post at sister WMIL/Milwaukee. The trio of Afternoons/APD/MD duties go to Boomer who comes to the station from a Dir/Promotions/on-air spot at WSLC/Roanoke, VA. Finally, nights and Promotions will be manned by Tyler Reese who steps across the hall from sister Z104.

Jonathan Steele has been named by Waitt Radio Networks Dir./Ops Chris Reeves as Program Director for the Waitt AC-Active format. Steele has been Music Director for the format the past year and spent several years on-air in Denver.


