Prior to joining Nielsen Entertainment, Rob was Vice President - Marketing Services for Fairwest Direct, a San Diego based company specializing in database driven direct marketing programs and consulting for radio stations. Sisco has served as a programming and management consultant for radio stations and served on the board of the Conclave.

MAKING MEMORIES OF

CRS-37 kicked off in style yesterday (2/16), honoring those in the industry who have committed to giving back to their communities. This year's recipient of the Tom Rivers Humanitarian Award is none other than Minneapolis' own John Hines, morning man at Clear Channel KEEY. Hines has "done good" all over the place including raising money for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, heightening AIDS awareness and support of US troops in Iraq. Hines mused, "Large events, small events, it doesn't matter, all you have to do is throw yourself into them when anybody asks." Stations taking honors were: Small Market: Saga KDXY/Jonesboro, AR, Medium: Citadel WIVK/Knoxville, TN and Large: CBS Radio WQYK/Tamp, FL. The artist award went to Neal McCoy for his efforts with the East Texas Angel Network among other charitable endeavors. Toby Keith received the US Dept. of Veteran Affairs Secretary's Award for Outstanding Service.

The TATTLER commented, last week, on the postponed ABC Primetime report on payola. That report aired yesterday (2/16), and was followed up by an article published on ABC's website. The televised portion focused largely on Entercom's self-proclaimed former "golden boy" Dave Universal. The ousted T40 WKSE man was fired last year as Spitzer and the FCC began to shine the bright lights of their investigation into the dark corners and under the rugs of radio's questionable relationships with labels. Universal defended himself to Primetime interviewer Brian Ross maintaining that he only accepted payments after stations had already added songs, prompting Spitzer to snap back, "So he says, 'I was guilty of extortion, not bribery!" The web article focused on artist reaction to the payola issue, featuring comments from Minneapolis band Semisonic's drummer Jake Slichter. He is candid about the huge cost of creating a hit, as evidenced by their to the top of the charts in 1998, saying, "We definitely benefited from payola... It cost something close to \$700,000 to \$800,000 to get 'Closing Time' on the air, to keep it on the air long enough for people, for public taste to really grab on to it" These sentiments were echoed by various artists in attendance at last week's Grammys, among them industry vet Tony Bennett who stated, "Absolutely. It costs a lot of money to make something famous." Fiona Apple also chimed in with, "It's a business about money. People are trying to get what they want done, and they'll pay for it ... "

Part-timers **Rick Elliot** and **Craig Brollery** are getting their own weekly show on **ABC** Talk WLS/Chicago, according to **Robert Feder** in the **Chicago Sun-Times**. The new show will broadcast 6-9pm on Saturdays. Also new in the market is **John Grochowski** who will host an hour-long program on crosstown **CBS** Talk WCKG.

Monday (2/20) will mark the end of road for **Fairfield** Talk WKLZ/Kalamazoo, as the station shuts down and turns in their license to the **FCC**. This comes as no surprise as the company was granted an extended-band AM for five years, which comes to an end next week. Pres./GM **Stephen Travers** spoke with the **Kalamazoo Gazette** and said that this will result in no lay-offs, but it does leave the **Chicago Cubs** homeless in the market.

**Clear Channel**/Detroit has named **Til Levesque** as their new Market Manager. She comes to the position after 15 years in the CC family, most recently as Dir./Sales in Detroit. She'll over see ops at all seven of the cluster's stations (Sports WDFN, Classic Rock WDTW, Talk WDTW, Urban WJLB, CHR/Pop WKQI, Urban AC WMXD & AC WNIC). Levesque is replacing **Dave Pugh** who now handles RVP duties for **Clear Channel**/Washington, DC.

In a teleconference today (2-1), VP/Domestic Research **Dr. Ed Cohen**, announced **Arbitron's** plan to expand their diaries to cell-phone only households in 2008. This decision come after research revealed that said households tend to listen to the radio more than those with landlines as well as cell lines. All diary placements will have to be done by hand, as current law prohibits automated dialing equipment for cells. This presents some problems, as diary placement will have to happen by direct calls to consumer cell phones, potentially leaving them with a charge (or use of precious "day time minutes") for that incoming call. Arbitron plans to find potential diarists by process of elimination, calling cell users, ascertaining whether or not they also have a landline, and if not, asking for permission to use them as a diary subject. Alpena Broadcasting has sold controlling interest of KJRV/ Wessington Springs-Mitchell, SD to 25% owner Dakota Communications for \$75,000. Sorenson Broadcasting, Todd Robinson, Inc., and TG Partnership are bowing out with the sale.

**Nancy Skinner,** former WLS/Chicago and WDTW/Detroit host, is throwing her hat into the political. In an interview with the **Detroit News**, Skinner declared her intention of seeking the Democratic nomination to run against current Michigan 9<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Republican Rep. **Joe Knollenberg.** She'll have plenty of help in her campaign, as she plans to bring along radio friends like **Air America's Al Franken**.

**CBS**/Kansas City Dir./Programming **Mike Kennedy** told **All Access** this week that the moving and shaking at their stations is nearing an end saying, "We're not done yet, but getting close!" Here's what's already in place: Hot AC KCKC grabs T40 KMXV midday dude **Dave Fogel** to replace **Mike O'Brien** at afternoons. O'Brien isn't out of the cluster, however, as he's holding on to his Dir./Production-Imaging and swingman duties. Back at KMXV, **Greg Sage** will anchor middays as the station continues to hunt for a PD. Meanwhile, **Jeanne Ashley** steps off mornings at KCKC and slides to middays, making way for a new morning show that **Nycki Pace** and **Dave Johnson** have in the works.

Salem and Jon Yinger's Christian Broadcasting System station swaps have come to a close. The deal gives Religion WLQV/Detroit to Salem, in exchange for Religion WTSJ-Talk WBOB/Cincinnati, and a cool \$6.7 million. WBOB, which has been leased to **Dusty Rhodes** and **Brian Kauffman**, is currently operating as an Oldies outfit under the calls WDJO. Yinger, meanwhile, has applied for a change for WTSJ, looking for WCVX calls. John Pierce served as exclusive broker on both the sale and WBOB lease.

Looks like **Entercom** Talk WRKO/Boston Dir./Operations **Brian Whittemore** may be on his way back to his home state of Minnesota. According to the **Boston Herald's** gossip column, Whittemore will be stepping down and handing over his duties to **Jason Wolfe**, current PD at sister Sports WEEI.
