

There was a noticeably empty chair at last week's **AIR Awards**: **Saga**, owner of all three top FM stations in the Milwaukee Arbitron ratings. President and General Manager **Tom Joerres** said that his company would make a direct donation to the **March of Dimes**, in lieu of attending the awards that also serve as a fundraiser for the charity. Jorres said that a combination of disenchantment with other stations engaging in "virtual ballot box stuffing" and the fact that judges consist of people outside the Milwaukee area caused Saga to choose not to attend.

Alex Ostrovsky of West Bloomfield, MI got much more than he bargained for when he logged in to download Coldplay's Speed of **Sound** last night. The teen had just returned from enjoying the Brit band's concert, and wanted to purchase a song he liked. It turned out to be a lucky purchase. He won the hyped Billionth song download contest. For the \$.99 it took to purchase the song, Ostrovsky will take home a 20-inch iMAC, 10 fifth generation iPODS and a \$10,000 gift card good for any item on the ITunes Music Store. Apple will also establish a scholarship to the world-renowned Julliard School. Apple CEO Steve Jobs spoke about the larger implications of the milestone, saying, "I hope that every customer, artist and music company executive takes a moment today to reflect on what we've achieved together during the past three years. Over one billion songs have now been legally purchased and downloaded around the globe, representing a major force against music piracy and the future of music distribution as we move from CDs to the Internet."

Minnetonka, MN's Chapter 11-ridden **Musicland Holding Corp**. has been sold to **Trans World Entertainment** for an undisclosed amount. The former is the parent company of **Sam Goody** and **Suncoast Motion Picture Co.**, while the latter owns and operates **FYE**, **Coconuts, Strawberries, Spec's Wherehouse, CD World, Second Spin and Planet Music**. The deal is pending, subject to a competitive bidding process and court approval.

After being bumped off the air on flagship station **Clear Channel** Talk KFGO/Fargo, and jumping crosstown to Talk KQWB, syndicated talk maven **Ed Schultz** says he may leave Fargo altogether. He called his ousting at KFGO "classless" in an AP release, and expressed a desire to relocate somewhere where he'd have better access to a satellite TV uplink for appearances on cable news and network television shows. "Denver would like us. Miami would really like us. Seattle is very interested," says Shultz of possible destinations.

This week, it was announced that **Minnesota Public Radio** is suing **AI Gore's "Current"** cable network. Why? The public radio behemoth claims the former VEEP is guilty of trademark infringement because the TV network started calling itself "**Current**" four months after MPR applied for a trademark for it's triple A formatted KCMP "The Current"/Minneapolis. Gore claims his TV network featuring viewer-produced amateur news reports will never be confused with a radio station known for Billy Holiday to Billy Idol segues. He says over 300 businesses in the country use "current" in their names, and MPR seems fine with that. Besides, he argues, he never shot anyone while HE was in office.

One half of the wildly successful syndicated morning duo **Bob and Tom** has denied rumors that the team was considering a foray into the waters of satellite radio. **Tom Griswold** has spoken out against an **Indianapolis Star** article that suggested that a nightly highlight show had been pitched saying that their show, which currently airs in more than 150 markets via the **Premier Radio Networks**, had no plans to jump off terrestrial ground.

Those long-delayed indecency fines by the FCC are about to be released, according to several sources at the Commission-including an announcement of the scope of fines it will assess in about a halfdozen television indecency cases...the most notable of which happened at the 2003 Billboard Music Awards when Nicole Richie said "shit" to a national audience. COMMENT: Congress is ready to allow the FCC to assess \$500,000 fines for saying naughty words on the radio or showing forbidden body parts on television (Remember, a peek at Janet Jackson's breast has already cost CBS \$550,000). Have broadcasters ever asked Congress, is this fair? Is this how you treat other industries? Let's examine how the government deals with another well-regulated industry that employs more people than radio/TV: mining. In 2004 (the most recent year for which data is available), the Federal Mine Safety and Health Administration issued 65,635 citations to mining companies in America for safety violations. The maximum fine assessed? \$38,500. An industry which has caused 416 fatalities since 2000, including a dozen more killed already in 2006, has been assessed fines which peak at under \$40,000. An industry where a member says "shit" on the air is penalized \$500,000. Perhaps the time has come for broadcasting to ask Congress for some more numbers – like, how many people radio has killed by airing an illicit four-letter word? How many funerals were held because a nipple was exposed on TV? How many hypocrites does it take to pass a bill authorizing a halfmillion dollar fine to an industry too scared to defend itself, while slapping the wrist of an industry doing real bodily harm? And finally, how much longer will it take broadcasters to decide to defend this nation's hard-fought First Amendment rights, instead of running from their obligation to do just that? - TK

The **Future of Music Coalition (FMC)** has requested that the **FCC** make a move on evidence gathered by **Eliot Spitzer** that they believe indicates a serious, and perhaps inextricable, tie between payola and consolidations, with particular concern levied towards the move to **HD.** The Coalition holds that consolidation in both the radio and record businesses made payola-like practices both easier and murkier. It favors more noncommercial radio, including LPFM, and no further loosening of ownership caps or cross-ownership. Says FMC policy director **Michael Bracy**, "Congress is working on a revision to the 1996 Telecommunications Act. The FCC is about to re-start media ownership proceedings. Terrestrial radio stations just launched dozens HD radio stations in key markets. We need to make sure that the public airwaves are managed in a way that benefits musicians and citizens."
