

Congrats to Midwest luminaries honored at the **2006 NAB Crystal Radio Awards**. WJON/St. Cloud and KUDL/Kansas City were among stations honored on Tuesday (4/24) at NAB2006's annual Radio Luncheon. Other winners included: WILV/Chicago, KLVI-/Beaumont, KUZZ/Bakersfield, WHUR/Washington, KSL/Salt Lake City, WHAI/Greenfield, MA, KZBR/San Francisco. WOMC/Detroit morning man **Dick Purtan** was also honored at the luncheon, as he was inducted into the NAB **Broadcasting Hall of Fame**.

Sean Hannity moves across the Mississippi River in the Twin Cities, as **Clear Channel** FM-Talker KTLK has announced the addition of Hannity to its line-up beginning May 2nd. Like **Rush Limbaugh** did several months ago, Hannity jumps from **Hubbard** talker KSTP-AM. At his new home, Hannity will follow Rush Limbaugh and broadcast 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. CDT weekdays.

Chicago Sun-Times media columnist Robert Feder took CBS and CEO Joel Hollander to task this week for the company's recent moves in Chicago. Says Feder - "CBS Radio rearranged the deck chairs on the Titanic Monday, replacing the general managers of its two most rapidly sinking radio stations in Chicago. The same incompetents responsible for foisting Shane 'Rover' French on 'Free FM' talker WCKG-FM (105.9) and the 'Jack FM' format on oldies WJMK-FM (104.3) apparently hope they can buy themselves time by shuffling the suits in the stations' front offices. It's unlikely that any of the moves will do much to reverse plummeting sales at either station." But how do you REALLY feel, Robert?

Entercom announces the rollout of HD2 technology in Denver, Sacramento, Kansas City, Norfolk, Milwaukee and Providence. Stations affected by this in the Midwestern world are: KC ~ KQRX: Rock-Live Rock, WDAF/Country-Smooth Jazz, KUDL/Soft AC/ Classical, KYYS/Classic Rock-Deep Tracks, KRBZ/Alternative-Country. Milwaukee: WMYX/Hot AC-Live Blues and WXSS/Top 40-Comedy.

Like **Entercom** and **Clear Channel**, **Emmis** announced their own lineup of HD2 stations. Their St. Louis cluster will look like this come September: KFTK/Talk-Fox News, KIHT/Classic Hits-Classic Hit Spice (Hotcha!), KPNT/Alternative-Current Alternative and KSHE/Rock-Country Variety.

Congrats to PD **Mike Moore** of **Entercom** Country KWJJ/Portland on his promotion to Dir./Country Programming for the entire company! Before moving on to such great heights, Moore spent time programming WWKA/Orlando, WWYZ/Harford, WSIX/Nashville and KWWK/Rochester, MN. With gas prices across the country edging up to, and in some cases exceeding, the \$3 mark, it's no wonder that a promotion including offers of free fuel would cause a bit of a frenzy. Clear Channel T40 WKSC/Chicago, however, doesn't plan to let a few police officers and traffic jams keep them from continuing their Free Gas Fridays. PD and consultant Steve Perun spoke with AllAccess earlier in the week saying, "[The promotion] was outta control with local cops shutting us down as we are drawing too many people and causing way too many traffic issues ... but it makes for great radio on the Tic Tak Freak SHow. And, you know, we're gonna be out there again on FRIDAY at 5:15p, with free gas that's now running at \$3.30/gallon and rising."


