

The Mentoring and Inspiring Women in Radio Group has released a new Gender Analysis Summary that examines the disparity between women and men in high power GM positions. The findings show that fewer than one in five GM's are women in radio groups that own 12 or more stations, and 29% of these groups have no female GMs at all. In fact, it seems that women manage only 17% of the 4877 stations owned by groups holding 12 or more stations. They fare slightly better in these groups than in the industry as a whole, where they manage only 15.2% of more than 10,000 stations. Of the 123 groups that owned 12 or more stations in late 2005, the average group had 40 stations and 11 GMs, only 2 of whom were women. Thirty-six groups (29% of all groups with 12 or more stations), which collectively own 612 stations, listed not one woman GM in late 2005. The main exception to this unfortunate rule seems to be Clear Channel with the company's percentage of female GMs has rising to 24%, up from 17% in 2002. Among the five other groups that own more than 100 stations, Entercom and Citadel exceed the average with 28% and 22% female GMs, respectively. Infinity and Cumulus are below average with 14% and 13%, while **Salem** has only 6% female GMs. Along with the news that men outnumber women as radio GM's 5 to 1, comes this related fact from the **RAB**: total combined local and national sales figures for the U.S. radio dropped 1% for March 2006 over March 2005

This marks the first time in over a decade and half that the group has produced any music together.

Work may be delayed on the new **Museum of Broadcast Communications** being constructed in Chicago, according to **Robert Feder** of the **Chicago Sun-Times**. The holdup is a result of the state of Illinois being tardy in their release of funding to the **Pepper Construction**. That company is asking for the \$3 million they are owed for the work to date.
