Reports indicate the **Tribune Co**. may be considering a spin-off its broadcasting interests (25 TV stations and Talk WGN-AM/ Chicago.) The company has been reported as "seriously considering" the spin-off and has discussed the possibility with the Chandler family trusts (former owners of the Los Angeles Times. who became Tribune shareholders with the sale of the **Times Mirror Co.** to **Tribune** in 2000) the Chandlers, however object to the timing and strategy while still expressing enthusiasm of a spin-off possibility. A broadcasting spin-off may be an indication of the eventual demise of the company, which owns papers like the Baltimore Sun, South Florida Sun-Sentinel, Newsday, the Los Angeles Times and the Chicago Tribune. Knight Ridder, another major news group, was recently sold to McClatchy Co., which has dissolved the group, by spinning off some of the Knight Ridder papers like the Philadelphia Inquirer and the Daily News.

John Gehron, whose career has spanned 35 years, has indeed been hired to head up **Oprah Winfrey's Harpo Radio**. Formally, Gehron served as PD at WLS-AM, **Clear Channel** and Sr. VP/Market Mgr., and in a similar role for **Infinity**. His new role as Harpo's GM will include overseeing programming and overall operations for the XM Satellite's "Oprah and Friends" channel that will debut this fall.

Clear Channel's Country KZSN (Kissin' Country 102.1)/ Wichita's Rockin' Rick Regan will participate in government operation "Embedding" that will place him among troops in Iraq for 2 weeks. The program will feature Regan's live broadcasts via satellite several times a day as well as daily audio, print reports, and photographs. Regan's "Iraq Trip" daily blog can be found on the KZSN website www.kzsn.com in mid to late June.

6/6/06 didn't pass over horn-raising rock station Emmis Rocker KSHE/St. Louis unnoticed. Someone or *something* took over the airwaves for a scary 15 hours. A rattled Rick Balis (Emmis/St. Louis VP/Director of Programming) explains: "Our music was scheduled like always, but what came out of the speakers was frighteningly different." Not their regularly scheduled programming at all, instead, listeners were creeped out by music from Mike Oldfield's Tubular Bells album, better known as music from "The Exorcist". If that wasn't weird enough, the KSHE jocks banter was incoherent. When a few shaken listeners recorded and played the air-checks backwards, it was not the regular DJ fare but excerpts from the Book of Revelations. Listener's who raced to their computers to check out KSHE95.com to find out what was going on were treated to graphics that flipped backwards every 66 seconds. And listeners with RDS-equipped stereos read "KSHE 666" on their displays. All this was too much for **Balis** who has been reported to have been forcibly removed from the stations premise during what witnesses describe as a breakdown, or possible possession by an evil spirit. Apparently, Balis kept screaming that he was Linda Blair and would someone please get him some pea soup! Things calmed down as the clock struck 12:01 Wednesday morning and all evil demons have left the building, at least for another century.

Three Wisconsin stations changed owners in the **Seehafer Broadcasting/NRG Media** swap. **NRG** closed the deal on Wednesday (5/31) and promptly flipped Classic Hits WLRK (Rock-It 107.9)/Wausau to Rock Hits at Noon Thursday (6/1) with new call letters WBCV. **Seehafer** got Talk WDLB-AM/Marshalfield, Sports WOSQ/Spencer, WI, and Talk WFHR-AM/Wisconsin Rapids, WI in the trade.

Nine Quarnstrom Media Group, LLC stations were sold to Curtis Squire, Inc.'s Red Rock Radio Corp. The stations include, Adult Standards KKIN-AM and Classic Country KKIN-FM/Aitkin, MN, AC KGHS-AM and Country KSDM (K-104)/International Falls, Country KFGI (Froggy 101.5)/Crosby, MN, Adult Standards WHSM-AM and Classic Hits WHSM-FM (Classic Magic 101)/Hayward, WI, Classic Hits WXCX/Siren, WI, and Hot AC WLMX (MIX 105)/Balsam Lake, WI. The deal closed at a reported \$7.5 million.

No word on a replacement....Northwest Missouri State University noncommercial KXCV-KRNW/Maryville, MO's GM Sharon Bonnett has announced her plans to retire on June 30. Bonnett has served over 34 years with the school, 21 of them as GM.

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CBS Radio AC KEZK (Soft Rock 102.5)/St. Louis's "Komen St. Louis Race For The Cure" is welcoming nationally syndicated radio host **Delilah** to participate in the events the race will take place on Saturday, June 10th at 8am, MCing the main stage is **Delilah** and KEZK midday host **Kris Kelly**. KEZK is also providing a jetcopter with traffic, parking, and Metro-link updates starting at 6am with **Ed Goodman** and **Cindy Collins** broadcasting live from the race site.

Bob Shomper has been named **Tribune** News/Talk WGN-AM/Chicago's new PD, effective July 5. Previously, **Shomper** held the OM/PD position at **ABC** WBAP-AM/Dallas/Ft. Worth.

A Battle Royale is scheduled between **Geraldo Rivera** and syndicated radio personality **Mancow** on Friday, June 9th for "Geraldo at Large". The two will spar over still undisclosed topics. **Mancow** will also present **Geraldo** with a special gift, also undisclosed in nature.

Starting with the 2007 season, **Indianapolis Colts** fans will need to tune into **Emmis**/Indianapolis's Country WLHK (Hank FM) and News/Talk WIBC-AM to hear games. Currently, The Colts are aired on **Clear Channel** Rock WFBQ.

lowa State University's Cyclones football and men's basketball games will be broadcast on KXNO-AM/Des Moines Adult Hits KDRB (100.3 The Bus) starting with the 2006 football season. The games moved from Clear Channel Sports KXNO-A/Des Moines. The Bus will serve as flagship for the Cyclone's 33-station network. John Walters and Eric Heft will remain as the broadcast team for the Cyclones and the football and men's basketball coaches' shows will stay on KXNO.

A 12-hour radiothon hosted by Sports WTKA-AM/Ann Arbor with the **University of Michigan** football team will take place on Wednesday, June 7th at 7 am in an effort to raise money for a new **U.C.M.S. 


