The demos will be provided from various HD Radio broadcasting outlets from around the country. Ibiquity Radio's Don Kelly will be along for the ride and available to answer the questions to all your HD Radio needs.

2006 SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS! The Conclave is proud to announce the recipients of its 2006 radio and music industry scholarship program, fulfilling one of the most important aspects of the Conclave's ongoing mission to educate and find the best and brightest industry professionals of tomorrow, today. The recipients, who are all expected to be on hand at "Conclave 2006: Future Tense!" will be awarded their scholarships during the Arbitron Awards Luncheon at the Marriott City Centre in Downtown Minneapolis on Saturday, July 15. Collectively, the 2006 scholarships are valued at over \$65,000. The Conclave's Specs Howard School of Communication Arts Scholarship, given in memory of the legendary Bill Gavin, is awarded to **Deven** Khrucell of Pontiac, Michigan, who will enter that school's Radio & TV Broadcasting Diploma program in Southfield, MI. Andrew Culp of Portage, Indiana will receive the Dennis Becker Scholarship, given in memory of one of the Conclave's founding fathers and a long-time Brown Institute educator. Culp will apply his scholarship to earning an Associate of Applied Science Radio Degree from Brown College in Minneapolis, MN.The McNally Smith College of Music scholarship this year has been awarded to **Kyle Frenette** of Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin. Frenette will work to earn his Degree in Music Business from the St. Paul, MN based school. In addition to the three full scholarships, the Conclave also announces the three winners of the \$1,500 Doug Lee Memorial Baccalaureate Scholarships - presented in honor of the Conclave's founder - which will be awarded to the following students in the state of North Carolina: Chairity Holloway of Winston-Salem State, Richard Leiman, from the University Of North Carolina-Charlotte and Christopher James Bacon of North Carolina State University.

At the FCC's open hearing Wednesday, a vote decided the Commission will re-launch its media ownership rules and review with six hearings across the country. Chairman Kevin Martin said that the Commission will approach the matter differently this time, not quelling Commissioners Michael Copps and Jonathan Adelstein fears, calling for more public response to specific proposals. Martin countered that the two were "rushing to judgment". The NAB issued a statement in support of the FCC's action, saying "is pleased the FCC is moving forward with its media ownership review, and we hope the outcome brings greater clarity to rules that preserve free, over-the-air broadcasting's role as the premiere news, information and entertainment source for tens of millions of Americans." The public has 120 days to comment on the proceeding.


LEARNING CONFERENCE EXPLORES NEW PARADIGM!


