Ladd had been released on bond, but the court found probable cause for a trial and denied a defense motion to dismiss the case. Uecker obtained a temporary restraining order against the Illinois woman earlier this month, after claiming Ladd had been stalking him for years.





As expected, President Bush signed the new broadcast indecency bill into law a couple of weeks ago, increasing the maximum fine for indecency to \$325,000 per violation (a tenfold increase over the old limits). Here's the NAB response from **Dennis Wharton**: "In issues related to programming content, NAB believes responsible selfregulation is preferable to government regulation. If there is regulation, it should be applied equally to cable and satellite TV, and satellite radio." COMMENT: While the question of equal application of indecency statutes may indeed be important to consider, the larger fight broadcasters should be waging immediately is the quest to have Congress finally determine what is obscene and what is not. When the incidental showing of a body part on TV provokes a six digit fine while Dan Ingram's utterance of the F-word is allowed to be aired without incident or fine because the Parents Television Council wasn't listening, it's apparent that broadcasters are in for the fiscal fight of their lives as long as special interest groups like the PTC will be defining obscenity for the government. If the industry focus remains only on what cable and satellite are allowed, the obscenity fight is one that over-the-air radio and television seem destined to lose. If radio-TV continues to pursue its 'do it to them, too' mentality, it will have already lost round
