
Clear Channel country KEEY/Minneapolis's morning stalwart **John Hines** came under a bit of local fire earlier this week for comments made earlier this month about celebrity baby **Zahara Jolie Pitt**.

Zahara's name came up when Hines and company discussed a news story about actor Jon Voight sending happy birthday wishes to grandson Maddox Jolie Pitt. Voight had apparently not met any of the children of his estranged daughter, Angelina Jolie and reputedly had botched the name of granddaughter Zahara in an interview in early September. John ran with Voight's faux pas, as the morning crew tossed out the names Chaka Khan and Scheherazade. Hines chimed in: " 'He could have said Chocolate Monkey for all I know and what would the difference be? He's never met the kids." Zahara Marley Jolie Pitt - a black child - was born in Ethiopia, orphaned by AIDS-stricken parents and adopted by Jolie in July 2005. The station did receive a complaint about Hines' remark, a complaint a local newspaper gossip columnist used to vilify the morning man. Said Hines to the columnist, "(If I would have known the origin of Zahara) I certainly wouldn't have made that comment. Oh, I've got a lot of issues, honey, but [racism] is not one of them." Last week, while he was on vacation, he went on the air to apologize but the columnist (CJ Johnson) was unrelenting, writing that the listener who complained had "trouble swallowing (the apology)." Comment: John - who was named 2006 Country Radio Broadcasters Humanitarian of the Year last winter for his work with area charities - said he had no idea Jolie had been putting together a mixed-race family, and he's to be believed. In his reach for a laugh, he inadvertently crossed a line he had no idea he was crossing. The lesson learned? When in doubt, leave it out. Lesson 2? It doesn't hurt to pick up and read **People** magazine every now and then.

Congressmen Maurice Hinchey (D-NY), David Price, (D-NC), Sherrod Brown (D-OH) and Congresswoman Tammy Baldwin (D-WI) led 34 House Democrats in urging FCC Inspector General Kent. R. Nilsson to conduct an investigation into the recent revelations that the agency hid two studies on media consolidations from the public. Senator Barbara Boxer had previously called for a similar investigation. The House Democrats claim that such a suppression would amount to fraud and run in direct opposition to the FCC's stated policies of transparency and public involvement. Kevin Martin, current FCC Chairman, is conducting an internal investigation into the matter. The alleged report suppression would have happened under the watch of former Chair Michael Powell. Powell has publicly denied any wrongdoing.


