Paralyzed from the waist down in a high-wire accident in 1962, Mario Wallenda of The Flying Wallendas now uses a specially constructed "Skycycle", allowing him to personally continue his famous family's highwire act. Wallenda performed his death-defying feat last week from The Merchandise Mart in Chicago, crossing the Chicago River. Before his adventure, Wallenda admitted that that he had used the "skycycle" only once before. He added that he has wanted to get back on the high wire ever since his accident. "I had the bug even before I got out of the hospital," Wallenda said. "I had to change my life. They had some kind of shrink and he told me I had to change my life from circus to something else or I wouldn't survive and that's what I did. It used to kill me watching the family leave when they go on the road." The man who convinced Wallenda to perform? WLUP/Chicago morning legend Jonathon **Brandmeier**, who broadcast the successful stunt from the Loop studios - which are located near the site of the feat. Oodles of Chicago media covered the crossing – as did all of the major news networks!

Jim Ingstad returns to Fargo radio ownership with the purchase of seven stations from Clear Channel. Moving to Instad in the sale will be Talk KFGO-AM, Sports KVOX-AM (1280 The Fan), Country KDAM (104.7 The Wolf), Soft AC KRVI (The River 95.1), Country KFAB-AM (Outlaw Country 92.7), Classic Hits KKBX-FM (101.9 The Box), and Top 40 WDAY-FM (Y-94). The purchase terms were not announced. Comment: The TATTLER's long-held suspicion that the industry's megacompanies – unable to expand their holdings for a variety of reasons – would move into the break-up phase of the consolidation cycle. CBS & Radio One got the ball rolling earlier this summer with its announced intent to sell properties in selected markets, and now Clear Channel seems to be jumping on board with this sale that represents nearly 10% of all the commercial stations in North Dakota. Expect more events like this to happen, especially as the fiscal year draws near to an end for many companies.

Earlier this week, *The Detroit News* reported a judges ruling that will keep former **Radio One** WDMK-FM/Detroit air personality **John Mason** from starting his new morning show on WGPR-FM/Detroit until January 2007. Radio One, who had employed Mason on WDMK from 2001 until his contract expired on July 29, sued Mason in U.S. District Court on September 8 after it was announced he was going to buy time on WGPR for his new syndicated morning show. Radio One claimed Mason was in violation of his six-month non-compete clause, even with the purchased air time...and a district judge agreed.

Public and noncommercial radio stations will be eligible for reporting in Arbitron's local market ratings reports. This will become effective with the release of the fall 2006 survey. These stations will need to conform to the same minimum reporting standards as commercial radio stations, according to the company. Arbitron also says that it is putting off previous plans to report individual satellite-radio channels. It hopes to be able to include satellite-radio channels in 2007, according to VP/Product Management & Client Services Brad Feldhaus. Also beginning in 2007, Arbitron will begin collecting HD Radio facilities' information. These forms will mail in November.

Ivory Soap concluded its nation-wide radio search for the next "Ivory Family," a staple of the brand's advertising 40 years ago. The winner came from a regional search conducted by Newsweb's Chicago-area "Nine-FM" Adults Hits. The winners were Sandra Mecklenburg, her daughter Alexandra, and her mother, Maryrose Bell. They won the grand prize of a year's supply of Ivory Soap and a \$40,000 scholarship.

Rev. Jesse Jackson Sr. is moving his "Rainbow-Push Coalition" and "Keep Hope Alive" talk shows from Clear Channel WBRB-AM to WVON-AM/Chicago. Jackson says, "This is a fundamental change in Chicago (for African-Americans). When Harold Washington won in 1983, that was a first fundamental change for us. But this is a shift to a 10,000watt, 24-hour, seven-days-a-week station and gives us access to that we never had before." The "Rainbow/Push" will air from 10-11 am on Saturday and "Keep Hope Alive" will air from 7-9 am on Sunday.

After being convicted in July of conspiracy to embezzle, Jeremy Nordguist, former Michigan Public Media sales account executive, was sentenced on Thursday to eighteen months' probation. If Nordquist pays \$5,000 in restitution, he can reduce his probation. Two other MPM employees were also charged with taking gifts in exchange for underwriting announcements.

Changes. Entercom Hot AC WMYX/Milwaukee taps Tony Lorino to join Jane & Kidd for Morning Show Producer duties. Lorino is currently at KIOA/Des Moines, where he is APD/MD/Imaging Director...Lisa Fielding gets upped from part-time to full-time Anchor/Reporter by CBS Radio, effective next week...Jon Hemmer replaces Andi Miller as afternoon driver at Salem Contemporary Christian WFZH/ Milwaukee... Entercom Country WDAF/Kansas City announces the retirement of longtime morning man David Lawrence, but not his replacement.

"Answering the Call," hosted by Wichita Pastors Terry Fox and Joe Wright is coming off KNSS-AM/Wichita and Sirius Satellite Radio. Fox has stepped down from the Immanuel Baptist Church in a scandal over the use of church funds to help pay for the radio show. Fox claimed that the show was part of the church's ministry.



Cindy Barton received Botox treatments live on the air as part of a promotion, asking listeners to write letters explaining why they should receive Botox treatments, too. CBS Radio AC WLTE/Minneapolis, MN will be throwing a "Barton's Begging for Botox Party." The winners will be invited to a day at the spa.

PD Brad Savage is leaving Clear Channel AAA WQKL/Ann Arbor, MI for a similar post at Saga Communications' new AAA sign-on WCNR. Savage expressed regret at leaving Ann Arbor, but felt that he couldn't pass up the opportunity to work on a brand-new signal. He thanked Dennis Mockler, Rick Daniels, and Steve Goldstein for the opportunity. The new signal will be influenced by listener feedback, trying to carve out a new niche for itself somewhere between Triple A, Alternative, and NPR. OM Tommy BoDean has left Clear Channel after eleven years. BoDean has been working at Top 40 WKFS and Hot AC WVMX/Cincinnati, OH. Previously, he worked at Clear Channel sister Top 40 WZEE/Madison, WI. Bobby D also leaves his post as WVMX PD. Mark Anderson of Audience Development Group is going to hold down the fort at WKFS and WVMX.

Clear Channel Top 40 KDWB/Minneapolis PD Rob Morris heard Top 40 KKDM/Des Moines afternooner Steve Wazz's show and instantly tapped him for nights at KDWB. Steve will replace Scott Tyler, who is now Chief Engineer for Clear Channel/Mason City, IA.

Randy Lee will be continuing on to cover the Husker's football and baseball broadcasts, while his spot on the University of Nebraska's basketball radio network will be taken over by returning Kent Pavelka, former morning host at KKAR-AM/Omaha.

In a case the City Commissioner of Investigation calls "somewhat shocking," the former Gloria Wise Boys and Girls Club will pay New York City back \$625,000 of an \$875,000 grant. The city gave the Bronx charity the money, but it was diverted to an interest-free loan to Air America Radio. \$250,000 will go back to the charity for operational use. The case is still under investigation and has been placed with the criminal prosecutions bureau.

Effective January 1st, **Sean Hannity** gets his syndicated show renewed by **Clear Channel** for 80 of its stations. The deal is in effect for three years and includes clearances on WPGB/Pittsburgh, KPRC-AM/Houston, KFYI-AM/Phoenix, WIOD-AM/Miami, WKRC-AM/Cincinnati, and KTLK-FM/Minneapolis, among others. VP of Programming **Sean Compton** praised Hannity for his ratings and his ability to attract desirable demographics.

Crawford Broadcasting Urban AC WSRB/Chicago, a station that launched its current format in 2003, has terminated several personalities, presumably in an effort to cut operating costs. Midday personality **Fiona Verde**, night smoother **Mel Devonne**, and weekender **Jim Raggs** have all been terminated. The station ranked 28th overall with at 12-plus share of 1.4, according the latest **Arbitron** ratings. Currently, the station offers **Steve Harvey** in the mornings and **Michael Baisden** in the afternoon.

Mark Kassof & Co (headed up by former KDWB/Minneapolis air talent Mark Kassof) completed a survey about HD radio with 752 telephone interviews, completed from September 13-17. The results show that 5% of 18-64-year-olds think they're receiving HD Radio from at least one of the FM stations they listen to, even when they haven't purchased HD-capable radio. Among those who think they are listening to HD, 46% say it is "about the same" as regular FM radio, and 12% say that is "a lot better" than regular FM! 1% of listeners say they have actually purchased HD-capable radio, and two-thirds of these listeners say HD is "a lot better" than regular FM. "Stations contribute to confusion when they say they are 'broadcasting in HD' without offering an explanation of what HD provides and what is required to receive it," Kassof explains. "As a result, some listeners wrongly think they are receiving HD."

Representatives from a variety of groups, such as **Parents Television Council** (an anti-indecency group), **Children Now**, and **Disney** are joined by the **FCC** and Senator **Sam Brownback** (R-KS) in the formation of a new task force to investigate the media's responsibility for the current outbreak of childhood obesity. It will be called "Media and Childhood Obesity Today and Tomorrow," and will be headed up by FCC Chairman **Kevin Martin**.

The **Mentoring and Inspiring Women in Radio Group** has set October 6 as the deadline for the 2007 Mildred Carter MIW Group Mentoring Program. Journal Broadcast Group has closed on the sale of Spanish KBBX/ Omaha to **Connoisseur Media** in a deal worth \$3.8 million. **Kalil and Co.** brokered the deal.

John Pierce and Co. served as broker for the **Independence Media** purchase of Religion WVEL, Contemporary Christian WPIA, and Rock WIXO/Peoria from **Regent**. This was a \$3.8 million dollar deal.

Envision Radio Network's Classic Rock "Chop Shop Radio Show" adds KZCR-FM/Fergus Falls, MN as its latest affiliate.

In the last day of its "Fall Sharathon," Contemporary Christian **KWOF/ Cedar Rapids, IA**, needed \$70,000 to meet its goal. By 6 pm, the station had reached the \$175,000 needed to cover its operating budget!

Many condolences to those who survive KMUW/Wichita jazz host **Dan Taylor.** A longtime host on the noncommercial station, Taylor died Saturday at 75. His signature show "Taylor Made Jazz" was on the air from 1988 to 2001.

Joint efforts between **Saga's** rock KAZR/Des Moines and the **Army Air Force Exchange Service** (AAFES) raised over \$16,000 last week for members of the lowa National Guard. AAFES is the worldwide retail organization that serves the members of our military, their dependents, and retirees. LAZER 103.3's *Cards for the Guard*, featuring national recording artist **Buckcherry**, was held Tuesday at Val Air Ballroom. Portions of the ticket sales were donated directly to AAFES. The concert was followed by a benefit barbeque held Wednesday at the Post Exchange at Camp Dodge.
