


Emmis classic rock WLUP/Chicago fired weekend/swing jock Cara Carriveau, apparently because of her letter to the Chicago Sun-Times. Characterizing the letter as "the last straw", VP/GM Marv Nyren told the newspaper, "I don't think Cara is a fan of what's happening here. I have no problem with my people talking to you, but I want to have people here who believe in our industry and believe what we're doing is right." In her letter, Carriveau said, "It's unbelievable how many Chicago radio icons are not currently on the air in this town. It's amazing that we can no longer flip through the dial and hear Mancow, John Landecker, Fred Winston, Dick Biondi, Bobby Skafish, among many others. My heart goes out to those talented personalities, and I am empathetic to the many disappointed listeners. This situation is sad. Very, very sad." Will this episode become a free speech issue? Eileen Willenborg, Executive Director of AFTRA's Chicago local, thinks so, saying, "We are investigating the situation, and we are in communication with the company's attorneys." Nyren said that he and PD Tim **Dukes** told the newspaper they felt there were "more talented" people than Carriveau deserving on-air opportunities at The Loop including longtime Mancow sidekick Jeff "Turd" Renzetti, who is auditioning for Carriveau's shifts. Comment: The combination of a free speech issue and the dismissal of an on-air female to make room for a male - and taking those wishes public - doesn't sound very EEO-friendly, and could land the Emmis station in a heap of hot water. Stay tuned...

Minneapolis-based **Best Buy Co.** Inc. is entering the music downloading business. But according to today's edition of the *Minneapolis Star-Tribune*, analysts don't expect the Richfield-based retailer to get a very big slice. **The Best Buy Digital Music Store**, to launch this month, will charge 99 cents to buy a song, or \$14.99 a month for subscriptions that will allow customers to listen to — but not own — an unlimited number of tunes. It also will sell a companion digital player, the **SanDisk** Sansa e200R, costing from \$140 to \$250 for 2 to 8 gigabytes of memory capacity. (Best Buy already sells about 28 percent of the digital music players bought in the United States.) Best Buy said its market opportunity lies not in the online music store itself, which is merely a rebranded version of the existing



RealNetwork's Rhapsody website, but in the way the portable music player tightly connects to the service. But according to the newspaper, analysts say Best Buy faces an uphill climb against the popularity of the iPod, which Piper Jaffray says holds 78 percent of the U.S. digital music player market, and Apple's iTunes online music store, which sells 70 percent of the online music in the U.S. Best Buy said the decision to launch on online music store doesn't mean it fears that sales of music CDs are dropping; Best Buy's music CD sales, which contribute about 5 percent of total revenue, are down about 10 percent from last year. Will the Best Buy venture knock iTunes out of its leadership position? According to Phil Leigh, an analyst with Inside Digital Media, "Not a saint's chance at a political convention, and that's about as slim a chance as there is."

White House Press Secretary Tony Snow supposedly gave up his radio job to join the administration, but surprise: he's being regularly heard on Clear Channel Talk WHO/Des Moines. The New York *Times* reports that he's the voice for **Nu-Vu Windows And Siding** commercials – work that he did while hosting middays for Fox News Radio. Radio Iowa News Director O. Kay Henderson notified Snow about his presence on the radio (Henderson is heard on crosstown Saga Adult Standards KRNT) which prompted Snow to respond that the client's use of the spots was "unknown and unauthorized, and as soon as we found out about it a White House counsel called up and said, 'You really can't do this.' It's like, you don't have the White House press secretary flacking siding." The Press Secretary recorded the spots for Putbrese Communications Religion KWKY/Des Moines, which was an affiliate of his show; he says that the client does not have the right to air the commercials on another outlet. But at least for now, it's "Snow"-ing on Des Moines radio.

FCC Green-lights Nebraska Political candidates. Call-in radio shows featuring Nebraska Governor Dave Heineman and Senator Ben Nelson do meet the requirements for news programming, the FCC has ruled. The Nebraska Broadcasters Association, which produces the call-ins, requested the ruling after recently pulling the plug on one of Governor Heineman's programs. NBA director Marty Riemanshchneider stated that although their opponents had not yet asked for airtime, the request was a "pro-active" move. The FCC decided both shows qualified as new programs, since they are regularly scheduled, are controlled by an independent producer, and focus on issues rather than candidacy.

Clear Channel, the Center For American Progress Action Fund, Jones Radio Networks, and MSS Inc. are looking for the "Next Progressive Talk Radio Star." The contest starts next Monday with local promotions at participating stations with a final broadcast in front of a live studio audience in Washington in November. An "at large" portion of the contest will run on Talkprogress.Com, an offshoot of the Center For American Progress/Thinkprogress.Com. Jones/P1 syndicated host, Fargo-based Ed Schultz, will be a member of the judges panel for the contest. The prize? A nationally syndicated show featuring the winner
