

Wilks Broadcast Group, LLC, has purchased the Kansas City and Columbus, OH station clusters from CBS Radio. The deal includes Country KFKF (Country 94.1), Country KBEQ (Q 104). Top 40 KMXV (Mix 93), and AC KCKC (Star 102.1)/Kansas City, Rock WLVQ (Q FM 96), Classic Country WHOK (Country Legends K95.5), and Rock WAZU/Columbus. The clusters were acquired for \$138 million. "We are excited to add these assets to our portfolio and build upon the successes we have achieved in our other markets," Wilks CEO Jeff Wilks said in a press release. "Kansas City and Columbus are tremendous markets with dominating stations and employees that have consistently outperformed their competitors in ratings and revenue." This marks the second sale of entire clusters in the Midwest in the last 2 weeks by mega-corps; earlier, Clear Channel sold its 7 station Fargo cluster to Jim Ingstad for a rumored \$12 million (which, if the sale figure is true, it would mark a purchase to sale differential of nearly historic proportion, given Clear Channel purchased the cluster from the Ingstad consortium earlier this decade for a reputed price tag in the mid-40 million dollar range).

Clear Channel talk-show host **Tom Becka** has found himself in a vortex of controversy as the Omaha City Council decides whether it should demand an apology from him for a commercial parody, "Discover North Omaha". The parody is a tourism spot and highlights the gang violence in North Omaha. Councilman **Frank Brown** placed the issue on next week's council agenda, complaining that the KFAB spot has caused damage to the community. Becka's parody invites listeners to "discover miles of mayhem. Discover drive-bys. Discover gang violence... We've got a real sense of community here. When there's a shooting, we all stick together and don't rat on the suspects.... Arson, abductions, assaults. Everything that makes a community exciting. Discover North Omaha. After all, it's safer than Baghdad." KFAB removed the parody from its website and apologized "to any listener who found the parody... to be insensitive or offensive.



KFAB does not condone violence. We have decided to remove (the parody) from our website. The parody was meant to draw attention to some of the growing problems in North Omaha, however we do not want the parody we created to be the focus of attention. What needs to be the focus of attention is finding a solution to the problems of North Omaha."

Last Saturday (10/7), Bahakel rocker KFMW Waterloo/Cedar Rapids Middayer/MD Craig Laue was featured on ABC-TV's 'Good Morning America' to highlight the seldom spoken about eating disorder in men called 'manorexia', with which Laue (along with celebrities like Dennis Quaid) struggled with for years. The segment, which aired in the 7AM hour (lowa time) also featured Prof. Arnold Anderson from the University of Iowa discussing this little known disorder in men. 'GMA' also sent a Chicagobased crew to the radio station two weeks ago to film segments that might have been used in the story on ABC, including shooting scenes from the KFMW control room and also interviewing PD Michael Cross for the story. The crew shot some film of Laue walking in downtown Waterloo, doing a live break on the air on Rock 108, and eating lunch at a sushi bar in Cedar Falls. Laue was flown to New York last Friday afternoon. He was interviewed by Kate Snow on 'GMA' and was also able to watch the segment in his hotel room because they had taped the segment and ran it an hour later. The story also ran on XM Radio and can still be viewed on www.abc.com/gma. Congrats to Craig for his courage to come out and help other men with this disorder.

After denying the rumor for several weeks, **Air America Radio** has filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy. The network was forced to file when an unnamed creditor did not agree to proposed resolutions of outstanding debt and reportedly moved to seize the network's assets. The company's parent **Piquant LLC** continues to operate under a credit facility established by **Democracy Allies LLC** (a group with which Air America board member and largest creditor **Rob Glazer** is involved), with VP **Scott Elberg** upped to CEO. The network's filing indicates assets of \$4,331,265.30 and debts of \$20,266,056.23. Glaser is owed \$9.82 million in secured debt and \$475,000 in unsecured debt. Among other notable creditors, Minneapolis resident and Air America host **Al Franken** is owed \$360,749.98 in a priority claim.

Legendary radio personality **John Records Landecker** is said to be signing on with **ABC** Oldies WZZN (True Oldies-Chicago), reports Robert Feder of the *Chicago Sun-Times*. Landecker is best known for his time with the popular Top 40-WLS-AM, and was last heard at Oldies WJMK in Chicago (now Adult Hits "104.3 Jack-FM"). He will be one of two local personalities on the station.

Turner had an exclusive contract with ABC7, and has lost his bid to moonlight. He has taken a position as pastor, evangelist, and Bible teacher at **God's Amazing Grace Ministries**. Turner was driven off the air in 1998 in the aftermath of a drugs-and-sex scandal, and was rehired in 2000 by ABC7.

A change in the number of stations assigned inside the Kansas City market prompted **Cumulus** to apply to the **FCC** to transfer Top 40-Rhythm KCHZ/Ottawa, KS-Kansas City from the **Kansas City Trust**, LLC back to **Cumulus Media Partners**. The trust formed when **Cumulus** and its equity partners bought **Susquehanna** and had to spin off stations into a trust to comply with ownership limits in KC - remains the licensee of AC KMAJ/ Topeka (moving into K.C. with city of license Shawnee, KS). **Cumulus** told the FCC that a BIA analysis has increased the number of stations in the market to 45, enabling the partnership to reacquire the station...which this action seeks to do.

Sale-ing Away. **Big G Little O, Inc.** is selling Hot AC WUPM/ Ironwood, MI and Oldies WHRY-AM/Hurley, WI to **Bay Broadcasting (Gerald Hackman** and **John Nix)** for \$1.25 million in stock.

McVay Media President and Founder **Mike McVay** has announced that McVay Media will be parting ways with **Clear Channel**, although the company will continue to consult Clear Channel stations as well as other companies. McVay, a **Conclave Rockwell Award** recipient, commented, "It was clear that it made more sense for McVay media Consulting to be run independently. CC stations will continue utilizing McVay Media as well as continuing to use McVay to consult with Sr. VP/Programming **Tom Owens** on various content R&D products." There won't be any changes at McVay Media, and McVay states, "This change won't affect any service to our clients."
