

A settlement resolution has been reported from **USA Today** involving the "Big Four" broadcasting companies. Payments will be made to the **FCC** upwards of \$10 million after an extensive investigation by the FCC into payola accusations, according to FCC officials. Democrats **Jonathan Adelstein** and **Michael Copps** have been pushing for strict concessions, contrasting sharply with the Republican backing of lighter terms. On Wednesday, **Sen. Russ Feingold** (D-WI) appealed to the Senate Commerce Committee to put the pressure on FCC commissioners to take a hard line on payola. The commissioners will appear today at the FCC oversight hearing. Within the current terms proposed, broadcasters would commit to \$7 million of their airtime to independent music. Radio would shell out \$3 million to the **NAB** for training programs for stations to discourage payola.

In an ongoing story, **Air America** has a letter of intent to be sold to **Stephen L. Green's** SLG Radio LLC for a sum not disclosed. Green, a real estate mogul, will close the deal mid-February if it's approved in bankruptcy court. He's the brother of New York liberal politico **Mark Green.** Additionally, **AI Franken** is leaving the network after Valentine's Day, and **Thom Hartmann** will take his place.

Al Franken, 2005 Conclave keynoter, has started the ball rolling on his senate campaign against Sen. Norm Coleman for the 2008 election. Franken has begun making calls to his pundit friends and is declaring his candidacy. Speaking on the condition of anonymity, two members of the Minnesota delegation and one member of the Legislature have confirmed the calls, but did not want their identities revealed so as to disrupt Franken's announcement. Franken grew up in St. Louis Park, and achieved his success through writing for Saturday Night Live and becoming a best-selling author. In the past year, his radio show has moved to Minneapolis and he's become very active in Minnesota politics.

ABC News President David Westin has come under attack from three Arab-American groups this week. The organizations have pleaded with Westin not to let "Good Morning America" continue its plans to use 2006 keynoter Glenn Beck as a regular commentator. The demands come from the Arab-American Institute, the Muslim Public Affairs Council, and the American-Arab Anti-Discrimination League, all of

which cite remarks Beck made to **Rep. Keith Ellison** (D-MN), who is a Muslim, including, "prove to me that you are not working with our enemies." Beck defended himself, calling the statement "poorly worded," ABC has called upon parties from the groups to come on the air to discuss the issue. From the AP, Beck states: "My message is clear: Islam is a peaceful religion for over 90% of the world's Muslims. I have urged viewers repeatedly to understand this, while asking all of the proud, peaceful Muslims here in AMERICA to take a more visible role in our fight against those who make a mockery of the Quran. I also make airtime available, at any time, to any Muslim organization to help reinforce this realistic, peaceful view of Islam."

Former Market Manager Nancy Odney is being sued by Triad's Go Radio Broadcasting subsidiary for "violations of state law and confidentiality agreements." Odney exited the Triad cluster in January, joining Jim Ingstad's Radio Fargo-Moorhead cluster as COO. According to The Fargo Forum, Go filed the suit on Friday, hoping for an estoppel of trade secret sharing by Odney. Odney's attorney, Sarah Herman, has assured the press that the allegations have "no merit...either factually or legally." Herman also added that Ingstad has no desire to get into legal entanglements with Triad, but apparently "they want to start one."

Scott Eller Corelyou was arrested in his home in Conifer, Colorado, on Wednesday. The Denver radio personality was caught having an internet chat with an undercover agent, and is already in hot water with Fort Collins on charges of internet luring. Previously, he was accused of Internet exploitation of a child, an accusation that dates back to August 2006, when police say he orchestrated sexually explicit conversations with someone he believed to be an underage child. This incident most likely occurred before the one that led to his arrest by the Fort Collins police. Corteyou's show "Business for Breakfast" has been on the air for 10 years, where he's been the business editor for KOA and KHOW in Denver.

The verdict is in for agent **Todd Musburger** after a Chicago jury awarded him \$68,750 against his former client **Garry Meier**, according to the **Chicago Tribune**. The suit involved fees owed to Musburger for negotiating a deal for Meier with ABC Talk WLS-AM/Chicago in 2003, which Meier rejected. A former co-host with **Roe Conn**, Meier fired Musburger and then did not come to terms with his station. Musburger sued him for \$92,750, during a trial in which Conn testified that radio hosts' contracts were not linked by signed agreement, which opposed Meier's claims otherwise.

Local media coverage can be found on **Fox News, NBC 5**, and **WGN 9 Chicago**.

Doug & Mary, the morning show team for **Woodward Communications** Top 40 WKSZ topped off the station's Super Bowl promo this week by shelling out a big-screen, recliners, and several X-Boxes! Pepsi pitched in with sodas, one with the lucky red sticker on the bottom. 40 qualifiers got a go at a bottle (twice) and the winning bottle still had not been located!
