Steve Jobs, CEO of Apple, and several major record labels got into a war of words this week when Jobs called upon labels to give up restrictions on music sold online. The record labels would have none of it, and retorted that perhaps it would serve them better to expand its anti-piracy technology to business rivals. According to the AP, RIAA Chairman/CEO Mitch Bainwol stated that currently technology hurdles prevent

music lovers from purchasing iTunes and loading them onto devices other than an iPod. "We have no doubt that a technology company as sophisticated and smart as APPLE could work with the music community to make that happen," said Bainwol. Currently, other protections in place prevent the purchase of music from other online music stores. Jobs argues that lifting the copyright technology would do wonders for the online music marketplace.

A permanent injunction has been placed on the city of **Toledo**, as well as Mayor **Carty Finkbeiner**, in a victory for **Clear Channel** Talk WSPD-AM/Toledo. The restriction will keep the city and the mayor from withholding public news conferences or refusing entry to station reps. The dispute has continued between Finkbeiner and the station for some time over the course of his administration, coming to a head in June 2006 when Toledo officials barred WSPD from news conferences and a physical attempt to stop WSPD staff from a January 9 press conference.

New goings on at **Ingstad** talk KFGO-AM/Fargo, as **Ed Schultz** returns for his local late morning show, and **Larry Ristvedt** returns as co-host. But those aren't the only changes around the bend in Fargo; **Jack Sunday** and **Sandy Buttweiler**, former afternoon cohorts, are moving to middays 10:30a-2pm. Poor **Rush Limbaugh** gets blasted off the schedule!

According to the **Chicago Tribune**, **Sam Zell** has his eye on Tribune Co.! The real estate king and former **Jacor** investor has proposed a "complicated" move to the company, which involves equity stake, and accumulating debt to pay dividends to the company's shareholders. The Trib reports that Zell has powwowed with **The McCormick Tribune Foundation** about the idea and describes the talks as "preliminary." Zell's own company, **Equity Office Properties** has been the victim of it's own takeover battles since November of last year.
