

A deal has been reached in the joining of Sirius Satellite Radio and **XM Satellite Radio** this week. The companied have agreed to unite in a "tax-free, all-stock merger of equals." The value of the merger stands at \$13 billion, including a net debt of \$1.6 billion. XM stockholders get a fixed exchange ratio of 4.6 shares of Sirius common stock for each share of XM they own, under the terms of the agreement. The shareholders will own about 50% of the new combined company. Mel **Karmazin,** CEO of Sirius, is the new CEO, and XM Chairman **Gary Parsons** is Chairman of the enterprise. The board of directors will be comprised of twelve members, including Karmazin and Parsons, four independent members chosen by each company, and one rep from apiece from General Motors and American Honda. Hugh Panero, CEO of XM, keeps his role until the close of the merger, and new hires will be announced before that time. Each company will continue to operate independently until the transaction is complete. In a joint statement, Parsons and Panero said, "We are excited for the many opportunities than an XM and Sirius combination will provide consumers. The combined company will be better positioned to compete effectively with the continually expanding array of entertainment alternatives that consumers have embraced since the FCC first granted our satellite radio licenses a decade ago." The deal is still subject to scrutiny by the shareholders from both companies, the approval of the customary regulations and procedures, such as antitrust agencies and the FCC. Pending this approval, the transaction is expected to be complete by the end of 2007. Along with the announcement of the merger, the NAB voiced its concerns. Exec. VP/Media Relations Dennis Wharton was quoted as saying: "Given the government's history of opposing monopolies in all forms, NAB would be shocked if federal regulators permitted a merger of XM and Sirius. It bears mentioning that regulators summarily rejected a similar monopoly merger of the nation's only two satellite television companies, **DirecTV** and **Dish Network**, just a few years back. When the FCC authorized satellite radio, it specifically found that the public would be served best by two competitive nationwide systems. Now, with their stock prices at rock bottom and their business model in disarray because of profligate spending practices, they seek a government bail-out to avoid competing in the marketplace. In coming weeks, policymakers will have to weigh whether an industry that makes Howard Stern its poster child should be rewarded with a monopoly

platform for offensive programming. Were hopeful that this anticonsumer proposal will be rejected." The Pres. of Bridge Ratings, Dave Van Dyke, offered an opinion stating, "The satellite radio companies finally admitted to what many of us have known for months: The business model just wasn't working. And they're blaming it on the changing media landscape over the last 10 years since they applied for their licenses. Government bail-outs often leave a bad taste in our mouths, but it looks like the merging of Sirius and XM will be good for their businesses. Saving \$7 billion a year is a good start." The Consumer Coalition for Competition In Satellite Radio said it "is ready to oppose the merger and fight for consumer choice and public interest." Commentary: From the outside, this merger doesn't seem to stand a chance to weather a legal fight with FCC, FTC, or Congress. So, what does Mel know that the rest of the industry doesn't? Is the merger announcement a deflection of sorts to preoccupy everyone, while the principals prepare another, different end-game? Is a rejection by the FCC just what the satcasters are looking for: a ruling which could ultimately allow one of the two to threaten bankruptcy, which of course would create a de facto monopoly which in turn. Mel's PR machine would sav was caused by the government, which could therefore prompt quick legislation because Congress would not want to be blamed for killing satellite radio?
