A pervasive problem often discussed in the radio industry is the drop in consumption of tradition radio from Gen Y'ers, who are more tech savvy than previous generations and have turned to new media like internet radio and MP3 players. The latest findings on this trend have been released by **Bridge Ratings**. It includes the disturbing projections that the numbers of these listeners will drop dramatically if the radio industry continues to ignore its needs. Dave Van Dyke, President of Bridge, stated, "As far as the terrestrial attrition numbers are concerned, left unabated, I am concerned that what this study represents is significant drop-off in listening by today's Generation Y listener who will be come the 24-37 year olds of 2017. The good news is that a significant percentage of the Gen-Y generation wants terrestrial radio to offer programming that is relevant to them. However, that window of opportunity is closing." The Conclave Learning Conference will address these problems, as well as promising solutions, as a segment of the popular Conclave College on Saturday, June 30 during the 32nd annual Learning Conference at the Minneapolis Marriott City Center Hotel. 
According to a report by Reuters this week, internet giant **Google** is being sued by **Viacom** over Google's popular video-sharing site, **YouTube**. The suit is for over \$1 billion for "massive intentional copyright infringement." Viacom filed the papers at the U.S. District Court of New York, and also requested an injunction against further violations. The plaintiff claims that over 160,000 clips have been uploaded, and viewed more than 1.5 billion times. Viacom issued a statement this week saying: "YouTube's strategy has been to avoid taking proactive steps to curtail the infringement on its site. Their business model, which is based on building traffic and selling advertising off of unlicensed content, is clearly illegal and is in obvious conflict with copyright laws." The suit is the result of much "unproductive" negotiation with Google.

In Milwaukee, Clear Channel's Talk WISN-AM was renewed in spite of objections of the use of personality Mark Belling's use of the word "wetbacks." WTVN-AM/Columbus was challenged on the basis of "rapid qualitative decline in the programming and broadcasting," which was also dismissed. A woman in Joliet, IL, complained of defamation at Clear Channel's WVAZ/Chicago, amidst claims that syndicated morning host Tom Joyner has defamed her family for the past five years on air. She also complained that the station's public notice of pending license renewals were too few and far between. The FCC disagreed. In Rolla, MO, a petition for reconsideration of an FCC dismissal was denied, after the petitioner misstated a date of incorporation on the first application, which led to the dismissal.

Congratulations to **Clear Channel's** Country KZSN/Wichita! This week they raised \$133,011.87 for the Child Life Center Unit at **Via Christi Hospital**, with **Rockin' Rick Regan** hosting for a long 12 hours every day. This marked the first radiothon for the station, and the donations came from on-air pledges, and corporate donations. The money will stay in Wichita. The whole event was capped by performances from country artists **Rodney Atkins** and **Blue County**, who chatted with the kids on the air. Way to go, KZSN!
