The decision will raise competition to a new level by stimulating the growth in HD Radio stations, enhancing its offering to consumers and establishing a process for free radio to offer a paid subscription service for the first time." CEO of Sirius, **Mel Karmazin** has cited HD and its subscription services as viable competition between terrestrial and satellite radio at the Senate's anti-trust panels.

conduct. The man has been harassing Branch since 2003 when he began sending her letters and following her around the country. He's also been caught backstage after lunging at the singer while she was signing autographs. He was under a restraining order until its expiration in 2004.

Dan Mason, 1998 Conclave Learning Conference keynoter, has been named President/CEO of CBS Radio. He will now oversee the 144 stations that make up CBS's spread, replacing Joel Hollander and reporting directly to CBS Corp. President/CEO Les Moonves. Mason is once again the head of facilities he's run before. From 1995-2002 he was the President of CBS Radio, where he successfully integrated CBS, Group W, Infinity Radio, and American Radio Systems radio stations. He joined Westinghouse as President of Group W Radio in 1993. Mason's return to radio hasn't severed any ties with his partner Walter Sabo in Sabo Mason International Initiatives; his agreement is to take the President/CEO position at CBS Radio and allows him to keep his international consultancy business. *Rumor: Might Dan make a return to the Learning Conference in June?*

Garry Meier has been confirmed to be the new late-AM host at CBS Talk WCKG/Chicago! From 8-11 weekdays, Meier will be at the mic, helped out by Jim Turano as contributor. Opie & Anthony will move back an hour. A former partner of Steve Dahl, Meier and Dahl broke up their act bitterly in 1993, when Meier moved beside Roe Conn for the next eight years at WLS-AM, resulting in another messy split in 2004. However, Meier did appear with Dahl last summer, sparking rumors that the two had buried the hatchet and were considering working together again. The hosts remain separate for the time being, although in the same lineup.

The war is on between popular radio personalities Opie & Anthony and the controversial Mancow. The pair called Mancow to task on his "Foundation for Responsible Radio" campaign, citing a Mancow interview in which he said the pair were "failing miserably." He went on to point out that O & A are in "last place in Chicago, and I told Joel Hollander to his face that would happen. These are no-talent individuals, and they cannot survive in a post-Janet Jackson, post-911 world." O & A took umbrage with this attack, and ripped Mr. Mancow a new one, pointing out the loss of his Chicago and Des Moines affiliates, using stunts on guests and staging calls, (including painting O & A sidekick Jim Morton as a child molester) and his jump to calling an end to "shock jocks." During the XM portion of their show, O & A tried to get Mancow on the show to have a show-down, although the bit ended up falling through. Anthony posed as a caller on the Mancow show as "Tony from New York," stating he was interested in the Britain-Iran crisis). He made it onto the air, but was cut off before he could get any shots in. He then called back as "Steve from Denver," but was outed by the screener. Anthony then challenged Mancow to talk on the air, and the call was aborted. When Opie called later in a more civilized manner, the Mancow screener informed him that he'd made the last half-hour of his life "a living hell," and hung up. Anthony then labeled Mancow as a "brave guy in print," while Opie called him a "pussyboy."





Jim Labarbara hosted his last show this week at Cumulus Oldies WGRR/Cincinnati. The radio vet has been a staple of listeners for 38 years, but was told on Wednesday that his contract will not be renewed. His replacement is **Keith Mitchell**, who's been PD at WGRR since Cumulus acquired the station in November. Labarbara said, "I'm just shell-shocked now, trying to figure out what I'll do next. They said it had nothing to do with me, or my ratings, or my age. They said corporate wanted to make a change." He's spent 14 years on WGRR, and has also been in the market on WLW-AM, WCKY-AM and WSAI-AM. Jim was inducted into the **Ohio Radio/Television Broadcasters Hall of Fame** in 2000.

The Christian inspirational station WCDR/Dayton from **Cedarville University** has named **Marvin Sparks** as its new GM. He's the first new person at the helm of the station in 45 years, taking over for **Paul Gathany**, who steps into retirement March 31. Gathany started the station while studying at the university in 1962. What began as a 11.6-watt enterprise has become a whopping 30,000-watt, 14-station network, the **CDR Radio Network**. It is now heard in three states and streams on the internet. Congrats to both gentlemen on their accomplishments!

Journal's Adult Standards KOMJ-AM/Omaha has been purchased by **Cochise Broadcasting, LLC. Kalil and Co.** negotiated the deal. Journal has also closed on the purchase of **CBS** affiliate KMTV-TB/Omaha from Emmis, which they've operated under an LMA since December of 2005.



The results of the **NAB** board elections was announced this week! From the Midwest, **Bruce Goldsen, W. Russell Wither, Jr., Bob Bundgaard**, and **Matthew Mnich** were elected to two-year terms on the board, beginning their tour of duty in June.

Emmis/Chicago has raised some eyebrows by hiring a PR firm! Emmis RVP Marv Nyren reasons, "We know it's different for radio stations to go out and hire PR experts. But because what we're doing is so different, it really qualified as newsworthy. We're taking singularly unique approaches in both our programming and marketing, and we are prepared to talk about it." Emmis has asked MWW Group to create new communications initiatives for the Chicago station. They'll begin with an executive branding campaign, raising awareness and recognition of the stations' executives, touting them as innovative thinkers of the industry, especially in areas like fully-integrated and implemented 360-degree marketing, as well as the latest in PPM radio technology.

The new VP/Market Manager of **Entercom's** Madison cluster is **Amy Griesheimer.** Griesheimer's stations include Oldies WOLX, AAA WMMM and Adult Hits WCHY. Medium markets: **Broadway**/WBCT-Grand Rapids. Small markets: **Frank Rush**/WTHI-Terre Haute. Major market station nominee: **KEEY/Minneapolis**. Medium market: **KXKT/Omaha**. No Midwest small market stations received nominations.

The awards keep on comin'! **The Gospel Music Association** has also announced its finalists for the **2007 GMA/Christian Music Broadcasters Radio Station of the Year**. Major, large, medium, and small market stations all receive awards, with the winners being determined by a panel of judges reviewing the following criteria: community involvement, ratings, air-check and industry leadership. The winners will be announced before the 38th annual **GMA Dove Awards** on April 25. Large market Midwest nominees include **WCVO/Columbus (Dan Baughman)**, while regional small market nominees included **KKJM/St. Cloud (Deb Huschle).**

The Public stations of the year were WGVU/Grand Rapids and Michigan Radio.

For 45 years, (20 in Peoria), the popular personality has worked the industry!
