Sen. Herb Kohl (D-WI) has thrown his two cents in on the Sirius-XM merger issue. As Chairman of the Senate's antitrust subcommittee, he sent a letter to the Justice Department's Thomas Barnett and FCC Chairman Kevin Martin, asking them to oppose the merger as "unacceptable under antitrust law and as a matter of communication policy." His panel has listened to

testimony from Sirius CEO **Mel Karmazin**, along with many others lobbying that the relevant market for the merging companies is all audio delivery sources. However, Kohl states that "no other technology available today is a substitute for the satellite radio" and that "future technologies won't protect consumers from higher prices now."

Learning Conference Rocks On In June! The 32nd Annual Conclave Learning Conference, "Conclave 007: Radio Under Construction," will feature a three part rock symposium titled "Ratings, Revolution & Revenue" on June 29 at 5 p.m. at the Marriott City Center Hotel in Minneapolis. The session, moderated by Radio & Records senior editor/rock format editor Mike Boyle, will include interactive marketing director for Greater Media/ Detroit Jennifer Williams, VP of programming services and development for Arbitron, Gary Marince and Arbitron national PPM trainer Jenny Tsao. In Part 1 of the session — "Ratings" — Marince will lead an Arbitron PPM presentation about PPM data and how it relates to rock stations. He will also explain how smaller markets without access to PPM can learn from larger markets that currently use PPM. Williams will focus on how broadcasters can make the most of Web sites and new technologies for stations and listeners in "Revolution" in Part 2. Finally, in part 3 of the session - "Revenue" - Marince returns with Jenny Tsao will reveal what rock males are buying with a full Scarborough report. Each part of the session is expected to last 20 minutes. The last half-hour will be devoted to a Q&A session that covers all three parts. Since 1959, the Dalai-Lama has received over 84 awards, honorary doctorates, prizes – including the 1989 Nobel Peace Prize - in recognition of his message of peace, non-violence, inter-religious understanding, universal responsibility and compassion.

WVON also signed on as flagship station for Chicago Sky WNBA basketball. Les Grobstein will be behind the mic.

The sale of **Joy Public FM Radio's** five-station network to **Family Life Radio** for \$2.5 million has been closed. Included in the sale are KJTY/ Topeka, WJTF/Panama City, WJTF/Macon, KJTA/Flagstaff, and WJTY/ Dubuque.



The **FCC** has been urged by 14 members of Illinois' congressional delegation to move in a "timely fashion" on **Tribune Co's** request for temporary crossownership waivers, which would allow the company to hold onto multiple media properties in several markets while the Commission reviews its crossownership rules. Without said waivers, Tribune could be forced to sell some of its properties in its largest markets, as the company is sold to **Sam Zell** and an employee stock ownership plan.
