Conclave College 2007: The perfect ending to a perfect Learning Conference! (A complete agenda for next week's Learning Conference is found elsewhere in this issue of the TATTLER!)

The penultimate study on "Marketing That Works" and "The Impact of Present Day Ratings & the PPM," will be presented by Critical Mass Media at the McVay Summit during this year's Conclave Learning Conference. The 30,000-person, nationwide study by Critical Mass will demonstrate who is participating in research in 2007 and techniques to find them. Results so far indicate that building a panel for the PPM will be challenging-75% of phone calls aren't answered, and of the 25% who answer the phone, 80% won't answer the survey. The McVay Media Summit will take place from 8:30-Noon on Thursday, June 28 at the Marriott City Center in Minneapolis.

The Duke Returns to Radio! While the rest of the world was watching the last "Sopranos" episode and worrying about what would happen to the mobster version of "The Honeymooners," Dave "The Duke" Sholin was having a vision. When he heard Tony Soprano play **Journey's** "Don't Stop Believin" on the diner's jukebox, Sholin realized he could play that song again on the air, if he took the job he'd been offered as morning host at the new KFRC-FM (106.9) Tony Soprano's end could be a new beginning. "Sometimes you just know it's right," said The Duke, whose career started in the early 1970s at San Jose's KLIV-AM (1590), when the station played Top 40 music. "If you had to come up with a dream scenario, this was it." Sholin starts July 2 in the station's 5:30-10 a.m. time slot. He'll be working feverishly until that time in his post of VP/Astralwerks Records. Duke is the 2005 recipient of the Conclave's **Rockwell Award**, and sits on the organizations Advisory Board (Admission: most of this story was lifted from the San Jose Mercury, thanks, Annette Lai!)







Clear Channel Top 40 KDWB/Minneapolis morning host Dave Ryan spent \$19,919.08 for the microphone used by Bob Barker on "The Price Is Right." Dave Ryan was the lucky bidder in an ebay auction last Friday. Ryan agrees that spending nearly \$20,000 on a microphone is a bit extravagant, but he says it was worth it because he's a microphone collector and Barker fan. Ask Dave about it when you see him on the faculty of the Top 40 Symposium, "Tearing the Roof off of KDWB!" next Friday afternoon at the Learning Conference. In fact, you might even get a chance to see it in action!!

The successful conclusion of initial **HD Radio** conditional-access field-testing of traffic dates services at **Emmis** Alternative WKQZ/Chicago was announced this week! Sponsored by the trio of **Broadcast Electronics, Emmis, NDS**, and **Ibiquity Digital Corp**, the pilot testing occurred May 23-24 and was the first conditional access test for broadcasting real-time traffics information over the HD Radio system to vehicle navigational systems. The first round of testing inquired into the ability of broadcasters to allocate bandwidth and protect content for mobile delivery of traffic information, and also included authorization and de-authorization of the receiver for the data service, testing of end-to-end system functionality, successful reception/decryption of determine latency, and data stability in the encrypted channel. The testing, which was centered around the Chicago area, showed no dropped data packets or loss of service.

Northwoods League, a summer wood-bat baseball outfit, has fined Waterloo Bucks broadcaster Tim Harwood \$500 for calling into question the team's "credibility." Harwood made the comment on Fife Communications Spanish KDNZ/Cedar Falls, after the home team's manager, pitching coach, and two players were thrown out of Saturday night's loss to the Alexandria Beetles. He noted that league president Dick Radatz, Jr. called him up last Monday to discuss the comments, and the league will send him a letter demanding payment by noon on Monday. If further actions occur from Harwood, he'll likely be banned from broadcasting the league's games. Mr. Harwood is employed by the team, not the radio station. During last Wednesday's game, a group of four co-workers from Harwood's day job at The Technology Hut took a collection from fans to pay the fine.

Hundreds of invitations have been downloaded from the WLS web site for the broadcast that features live music from the **Play Doctors**, featuring Chicago-favorite Kimi Hayes, special guest **Rick Springfield** and a salute to summer in Chicago with the rollout of the infamous **Canarble Wagon** at 5pm.

A new bill to allow the **FCC** to eliminate third-adjacent-channel interference protection for full-power stations is coming down the pike, thanks to **Reps. Mike Doyle** (D-PA) and **Lee Terry** (R-NE). The purpose of the bill is to make room for more LPFM station. It was officially launched this week, with a twin bill circulating in the Senate, introduced by **Sens. John McCain** (R-AZ) and **Maria Cantwell** (D-WA), who attempted the same bill last year but failed to put it through.

Quinn and Rose, the morning show out of **Clear Channel** Talk WPGB/Pittsburgh, is adding another affiliate to their burgeoning syndication, with **Salem** Talk KYCR-AM/Minneapolis-St. Paul adding them to their lineup. **Jim Quinn** and **Rose Tennent** are now on 12 stations nationwide.

Media-Com Talk WNIR/Akron is back to being the home of **Kent State University's** football and men's basketball games in a newly-inked 5-year deal. The station will also air a one-hour pre-game show preceding football games, as well as a 30-minute post-game show. Basketball games will have a 30-minute pre-and post-game show.
