2007 Conclave Learning Conference Begins Construction of New Industry. The building blocks for a dynamic rebuilding of the radio industry were laid during the weekend of June 28-July 1 at the 32nd annual Conclave Learning Conference, as hundreds of industry professionals, teachers and students descended upon the Minneapolis Marriott City Center for RADIO UNDER CONSTRUCTION. Over 40 sessions covering every major radio format, technology and resource were presented to packed meeting rooms throughout the conference weekend. THE *TATTLER* has been presenting stories about the event originally found on the pages and websites of the Conclave's Publicity Partners. Here's the next installment from Radio & Records: E-Mail Marketing Tips That Work (by R.J. Curtis) In the final segment of an afternoon session titled "The Promotions Summit" at the annual Conclave in Minneapolis, a panel of three experts demonstrated "E-mail Marketing That Works." Craig Zimmerman, VP and general manager of PromoSuite, started by sharing statistics based on 116 million e-mails from PromoSuite data. The majority of station e-mails are sent on a Thursday, which is also the day most recipients open them, regardless of what day they were originally sent. E-mails are read at a predictable time — either mornings between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. or afternoons between 3 p.m. and 5 p.m. Eighteen percent of emails are read at least twice, while 39% of readers click on the links provided. Also speaking on the panel was **Jamey Garner**, senior account manager for **BIA Information Network**, and **Rebecca Falk**, director of marketing and promotion for **Clear** Channel/Detroit. Falk gave tips on how not to spam listeners, saying that coupons and discount offers are considered spam. Falk suggested utilizing client/product integration, surrounding ads with station information, or adding a client to a strong regular feature. She added that words such as "win" and "contest" should not be used in subject lines, and are usually caught in spam filters. Garner suggested stations use Web pages to involve listeners before, during and after concert or station events. He also suggested using a station webcam to give listeners a peek inside the world of the station. In general, Garner concluded, the Web should be used to pull listeners in, but eventually will also be used to push important station information out. When severe flooding struck parts of Minnesota last week, **Leighton** Top 40 KCLD/St. Cloud, MN hit the streets to collect supplies for the victims. Over a ton of supplies were gathered, and staffers were joined by other local stations who promoted and helped deliver supplies.

Interlochen Center For The Arts is selling FM translator W237CF/Mackinaw City, MI to Baraga Broadcasting, Inc. for \$25,000. The buyer will rebroadcast its WTCK/Charlevoix, MI over W237CF.Midway Broadcasting, which has shared-time WRLL-AM/Chicago is dropping its simulcast of sister Talk WVON-AM and will flip to Spanish as "Radio Latino" on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. WVON's Gustavo Rios will serve as Station Manager. The station airs on the 1450 frequency from 10-1 daily, and was the home of WVON for several years. It moved to WRLL's old extended-band 1690 AM frequency last year in an LMA deal with Clear Channel.

The League of Latin American Citizens revealed this week that it has issued an ultimatum to Clear Channel Talk WLW-AM/ Cincinnati Market Manager Chuck Fredrick to "fix the problem" of what LULAC calls blatant racial discrimination by Friday or it will organize a boycott in Clear Channel's top 10 Hispanic markets. LULAC is protesting the station airing a "speaking to an illegal alien" promo aired by the station after it previously apologized for billboards with a Mexican man and a donkey with the slogan 'The Big Juan," a play on the station's 'The Big One" positioner. LULAC Ohio Deputy Dir. Jason Riveiro noted, "By the end of the week, they have to give us a plan on what they'll do and how to prevent it in the future. Chuck has committed to calling us by Friday." Riveiro added that he doesn't accept Fredrick's previous explanation that the promos were old spots that aired in error. LULAC and other organizations held a sidewalk protest Tuesday at the station's studios, drawing 20 people. "We're not looking for words," said Riveiro. "We're looking for action. The ball's in his court."

**Mile High Sports Radio** may still be on the air, but it's no longer on KCKK-AM/Denver, the station that carried Mile High Sports Magazine's radio shows for a few weeks. The station is now streaming **Tim Neverett** and **Mark Knudson's** local shows. Programming is also continuing on KSXT-AM/Loveland-Fort Collins-Greeley in northern Colorado, which was simulcasting KCKK. The station recently made a quick change back to Classic Country.

**Turi Ryder** returns to her old radio home at **Citadel** Talk WLS-AM/Chicago, for more fill-ins this Saturday night. She previously worked at WLS in the Top 40 days before switching to talk at stations in Portland, Chicago, MSP, LA, and San Fran.
