


The Conclave is proud to announce the winner of its Continuing Education Scholarship for 2007: Kelly Jo Ann Schultz! Kelly is a professional play-by-play broadcaster - and radio salesperson - who has taken a "leave of absence" from radio to return to school as a full time student at Bemidji State University (Bemidji, MN), majoring in communication. The Continuing Education Scholarship is awarded annually to a registrant of the summer Learning Conference. Registrants who wish to enter the competition for the \$1500 scholarship submit an essay to the Conclave on the subject of "Why I Want To Receive The Continuing Education Scholarship." Kelly's entry was chosen as the best from all entries received. Here's an excerpt from her essay: "It has been my dream to be a sports broadcaster since I was a little girl. I grew up listening to Minnesota Twins broadcasts on WCCO 830 AM with my mom. Herb Carneal was one of my heroes, so was Al Shaver...However, it wasn't just sports that I listened to in my youth; I loved music! I spent days and nights listening to WLOL's Hines and Berglund and my all-time favorite disc jockey Phil Huston. I even slept with the radio on at night, excited to wake up with my favorite Twin Cities morning show and come home from school to listen again. Radio and television shaped my life and made me who I am today. I have dedicated my life to being the best broadcaster I can be!" Kelly will use her scholarship to continue her studies at Bemidji State!

Ed Schultz discussed the aftermath of his altercation in a Minnesota hotel on his talk show this week. It seems that Shultz and his wife became involved in an argument about the war in Iraq when, according to Ed, he put his beer down and stuck his finger in the man's face, saying, "I didn't come here for this." He and the man got into a shoving match, and while Schultz describes the incident as "harmless," he also points out that the only reason he didn't hit the man was because, "That's in my

contract. I can't be arrested." The fight was not reported to the authorities and the hotel's owner said, "It's not worth commenting on." Could Mr. Schultz expound more upon his passionate politics at the 33rd annual **Conclave Learning Conference** next June? Stay tuned...

Bill Cunningham, host at Clear Channel Talk WLW-Am/ Cincinnati apologized in person this week to Cincinnati Reds outfielder Adam Dunn, for accusing Dunn of playing "drunk" in a game in Pittsburgh. Cunningham is taking over Premiere Radio Networks' syndicated Sunday night slot recently vacated by Matt Drudge, and recently showed up in the Reds clubhouse to apologize for this comments from last Friday's WLW show, when he said Dunn was drunk when he misplayed a ball and also missed a base in the fourth inning, which cost the Reds two runs. He said that Dunn "looks like a monkey with a football in left field," and suggested that Dunn would have failed a breathalyzer test. Dunn took the comments seriously, although Cunningham claims he was merely joking.

An Illinois Congressman is aiming some shots at the hip-hop community for its controversial lyrics. The House Subcommittee on Commerce, Trade, and Consumer Protection Chairman Bobby Rush (D-IL) is convening a special session possibly titled, "From Imus to Industry: The Business of Stereotypes and Degradation" for September 25th. They will most likely be addressing the media "stereotypes and degradation" of women in hip-hop lyrics and videos, which critics have frequently derided for explicit misogyny aimed largely at black women. Rush has received commitments from UMG's Doug Morris, WMG's Edgar Bronfman, Jr., and Viacom's Philippe Dauman to appear before the panel. Rush stated, "I want to engage not just the music industry but the entertainment industry at large to be part of a solution. I want to talk to executives at these conglomerates who've never taken a public position on what they produce." He also noted that the music chiefs would be coming "reluctantly." Controversial rapper Master P, now a purveyor of positive messages, as well as "representatives from African American women's groups," will be in attendance, and one might expect that any label head would be hesitant about appearing for what looks like a "dressing-down." Rush, however, insists that the session will "not be an anti-artist hearing, or anti-music or antiyouth hearing...I respect the First Amendment, but right without responsibility is anarchy, and that's much of what we have now. It's time for responsible people to stand up and accept responsibility."







The **FCC** has renewed the licenses of five **Emmis** stations in Indiana, over the protests of a Chicago man whose battles against former Emmis Alternative WKQX/Chicago morning man **Mancow Muller** led to indecency fines for the company. The FCC cited Emmis' consent decree payment of \$300,000 in 2004 in rejecting



David Edward Smith's challenge to the license. "The Emmis consent decree not only wiped out previous FCC fines assessed against WKQZ and 35 pending complaints, but it quashed my right as a citizen to effectively be part of the process of making sure that our publicly owned airwaves remain decent," said Smith. "The FCC does not actively monitor the airwaves, but relies on citizen complaints. What the FCC did to me in siding with big broadcasting is unconscionable."

Another pair of stations in the **Aloha Station Trust** have been added, with Oldies WQOL/Vero Beach and Talk WMEQ/Menomonie, WI being placed in the trust holding several **Clear Channel** licenses pending approval of the company's del to go private. . Clear Channel also added Rock WRQK/Canton, OH, and Adult Standards WMHG-AM/Muskegon, MI to the list of stations of be transferred to the new private CC entity; the newest stations were picked up from **Cumulus** subsequent to the merger application.

More FCC deals: Christian Action Team, Inc, sells noncommercial Contemporary Christian KNGM/Emporia, KS to Great Plains Christian Radio, Inc, for \$32,000. Jay Vavricek and Alan Usher's Legacy Broadcasting is buying three Scottsbluff-Gering, NE stations from Michael Tracy's Tracy Broadcasting Co. for an undisclosed price. The stations, which are being operated by Legacy under and LMA that commenced Saturday, are Classic Rock KMOR-AM, AC KOZY-FM, Talk KOLT-AM, and Oldies KOAQ-AM. KOZY recently moved to KMOR's 101.3 FM spot, and KMOR dropped Country and moved to 93.3 FM, the new frequency for the former KOZY-FM, which moved form 103.0 FM.

12 stations have been sold to **Three Eagles Communications** in Minnesota and Iowa from **Clear Channel.** Classic Rock KXLP, Sports KYSM-AM, and Country KWMT-AM/Fort Dodge; and Adult Standards KCHA-AM, AC KCHA-FM, Country KCZE, Talk KGLO-AM< Country KIAI, Classic Rock KLKK, and Top 40 KSMA/Mason City were included in the deal. Three Eagles is reportedly spinning of the Mason City stations to **Coloff Media** and has filed to spin KXLP to **John Linder.**

2007 Conclave Learning Conference Begins Construction of New Industry. The building blocks for a dynamic rebuilding of the radio industry were laid during the weekend of June 28-July 1 at the 32nd annual Conclave Learning Conference, as hundreds of industry professionals, teachers and students descended upon the Minneapolis Marriott City Center for RADIO UNDER CONSTRUCTION. Over 40 sessions covering every major radio format, technology and resource were presented to packed meeting rooms throughout the conference weekend. THE TATTLER has been presenting stories about the event originally found on the pages and websites of the Conclave's Publicity Partners. Here's the next installment from Radio & Records. The 30-Under-30 Conclave College Supersession (by Chuck Taylor) Age is but a number. That was among the topics covered Saturday, June 30, at the Conclave Under-30 Supersession, based on Edison Media Research's search for young leaders under the 30-year-old threshold. Moderator **Daniel Anstandig** from McVay Media, one of the 30 himself, says he has gotten some interesting looks from clients who have spoken to him on the phone, and once they meet in person see that he is a whippersnapping radio pro in his early 20s: "They come around after they get why you're there, which is to win and compete and do good radio. Slowly, the age issues fade into the background." Bo Matthews, PD of Clear Channel rock WMMS/Cleveland, added that the game is about mutual respect. "People are people and we have to learn as much as we can. Age shouldn't become a hurdle on either side." On a few occasions, Michael Bryan, PD of Clear Channel CHR/top 40 WXXL/Orlando, says that he has dealt with an age-old mentality with some senior executives who have a this-is-the-way-we've-always-done-it mindset. "Sometimes it is hard to get people to change their minds and recognize the value you can add. But for the most part, good managers want the input of someone who is younger."
