

Cartoons Pilfered by Lenny Bronstein & Jay Philpott

The nation watched as a **Duluth** court decided yesterday that Jammie Thomas was guilty of copyright infringement for 24 recordings she shared over peer-to-peer service Kazaa. The verdict for \$222,000 in damages came in the first trial held in a suit filed against a consumer by 6 major labels for P2P filesharing. The RIAA, who pursued the case, issued this statement: "We welcome the jury's decision. The law here is clear, as are the consequences for breaking it. As with all our cases, we seek to resolve them quickly in a fair and reasonable manner. When the evidence is clear, we will continue to bring legal actions against those individuals who have broken the law. This program is important to securing a level playing field for legal online music services and helping ensure that record companies are able to invest in new bands of tomorrow." The labels sued the single mother for 24 recordings, a sample of the 1,702 audio files they claimed Thomas shared over Kazaa two winters ago. The recordings included titles by Janet Jackson, Richard Marx, Journey, Godsmack and Green Day. The labels claimed that their digital sleuth SafeNet detected an individual using a specific IP address and the username tereastarr@kazaa to distribute 1,702 audio files in the individual's "shared" folder on her computer. Charter **Communications**, identified as the ISP associated with her IP address, identified her as the offending subscriber. Thomas denied that she was involved in any file sharing. The jury didn't believe her and awarded the labels \$9,250 per recording, finding that Thomas willfully infringed the labels' recordings. At press time, there was no word on whether or not she would appeal the verdict.

A few weeks ago, the *TATTLER* told you a Cincy talk station was under fire by Hispanic groups for what they claimed to be

anti-Latino marketing campaigns, Clear Channel talker WLW and host Bill Cunningham enraged the Muslim interest group CAIR by asserting that one of the goals of Islam to is have "sex with children for eternity." The Cincinnati office of the Council On American-Islamic Relations' Ohio chapter (CAIR-OHIO) is now insisting that Cunningham be reprimanded for saying "The great war of this generation's time is the war against Islamic fascists ... They do not live for life, they live for death. Only through death can they believe they can be with those 72 virgins in heaven and have sex with children for eternity, which is the goal of that religion." Cunningham had already come under community scrutiny when he was forced to apologize to apologize to Cincinnati Reds player Adam **Dunn** for suggesting that Adam played while inebriated. This new controversy comes just days before his "Voice of the Common Man" show replaces Matt Drudge's Sunday show on 325 stations, nationally.

Working the Phone-ies/Premiere's Rush Limbaugh accused DC Democrats as being behind the call to censure him for his comments on anti-war troops, and further accused them of misrepresenting his comments in an attempt to discredit him. "This is not just the anatomy of a smear. There's much more going on with this than just smearing me. There is an attempt, I think, as they have done throughout my career, to discredit me. Using the traditional verbal crutch used by so many talk-show hosts to identify the opposition - "These people" - he said, "have had three, four days now to learn the truth about this, and they no doubt know the truth, which doesn't matter. What they are trying to do is flood a false story into the 'drive-by media' and have that survive and suffice as the evidence and as the story of what I said when it wasn't." Senate Democrats demanded an apology for his remark to a pro-war soldier that that the soldiers promoted in the news media as representing anti-war sentiment in the military are "phony soldiers." Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid said, "Rush Limbaugh took it upon himself to attack the courage and character of those fighting and dying for him and for all of us. Rush Limbaugh got himself a deferment from serving when he was a young man. He never served in uniform. He never saw in person the extreme difficulty of maintaining peace in a foreign country engaged in a civil war. He never saw a person in combat. Yet, that he thinks his opinion on the war is worth more than those who have been on the front lines. Rush Limbaugh owes the men and women of our armed forces an apology." Limbaugh defended himself, indicating the "phony soldier" was Jesse Macbeth, who was convicted of fraud and had falsely claimed to have participated in war crimes in Iraq. Limbaugh could not explain why he then used the plural "soldiers" when he claimed to have been speaking about one person. Commentary - Clear Channel's Mark Mays correctly defends his host's right to speak his mind, citing Rush's First Amendment freedoms. One can only wonder how Mays might have responded had Limbaugh added "...and nappy-headed ho's" to his acerbic barb. Still, we don't fault Limbaugh for his seemingly unpatriotic faux pas. We think it may have just been the oxycontin talking. - TK

Radio One's Indianapolis properties - Top 40/Rhythmic WHHH, Urban AC WTLC, Smooth Jazz WYJZ and Black Gospel WTLC – are the subject of a suit being brought by a



former employee. **Denise Redding**, a former company comptroller, said she was terminated because she is African-American and because she refused to sign-off on certain financial statements. She claimed one of her bosses - Radio One VP/GM **Chuck Williams** – used those statements to misrepresent revenue results and alleges that WILLIAMS (a Caucasian male) treated African-American staff members – including her - differently. A lawyer for the company, **Brandon Shelton**, said "There is no merit in Ms. Redding's allegations and we believe the litigation process will reveal that. " Redding is asking for owed benefits and \$80,000 in back pay, adding additional monies for emotional distress.
