As they have been from time to time, Citadel Classic Rock KQRS Minneapolis personality **Tom Barnard** and his show's co-hosts are under fire for insensitive on-air comments. In a broadcast last month, Barnard and co-host Terri Traen were discussing a state Health Department report that found that Beltrami County had Minnesota's highest rate of suicide among young people. They mentioned that Bemidji and the Red Lake Indian Reservation were both in that county, and then Traen commented "Maybe it's genetic; isn't there a lot of incest up there?" The American Indian Movement (AIM), the Red Lake Indian Reservation, and urban Indian leaders met with executives from the station in protest of the on-air comments. Among other things, the station agreed to an on-air apology and to hire more Native American interns. This isn't the first time Barnard's show has been criticized by minority groups; in the past they have also managed to offend the Somali and Hmong communities with their broadcast discourse.

Clear Channel Cincinnati is also under criticism for Talk WLW-AM's offensive advertising. **The League of United Latin American Citizens** has demanded that the station assemble a community advisory board after two incidents that LULAC found offensive to Mexicans. The first offense was a billboard with the slogan "The Big Juan," which depicted a stereotypical Mexican man with a donkey. The second was a promo that included "helpful phrases" for illegal immigrants. The new advisory board will meet monthly, and is composed of 15 community leaders including LULAC Ohio Deputy Director **Jason Paul Rivero**.

Miami University of Ohio is seeking cooperation from two Dayton public radio stations to ease the budgetary pressure of running their noncommercial WNUB Miami, OH station. After a 10-month review, a committee appointed by the school recommended that the school either seek collaborations or lease the station to another operator. They are currently in talks with **Antioch University NPR** affiliate WYSO Yellow Springs, OH and **Dayton Public Radio** Classical WDPR. Last year the school subsidized the station, covering about 62% of its \$1.7 million budget.



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There is some speculation in Chicago that the legendary duo of **Steve Dahl** and **Garry Meier** could eventually reunite for mornings on **CBS** Adult Hits WJMK (JACK-FM). On Monday CBS cut every WCKG show except for Dahl's to make way for a format change next month. Dahl will finish out the week there before shifting over to WJMK for the 5:30-10:00 AM slot next week. He and Meier broadcasted together from 1979 until 1993, when they bitterly split ways. Dahl addressed the possible reunion on the air, saying, "I wasn't opposed to having him join us in mornings, but that's not something that he wants to do right now." Whether this could still change in the future remains to be seen, as Meier could not be reached for comment.

The FCC held another meeting to discuss localism on Wednesday (10/31). The comments from the longstanding Commissioners were predictable, while the new Commissioners stayed rather decidedly on the fence. Commissioner Michael Copps reiterated his familiar argument against consolidation as a major threat to localism. "The bottom line here," he said, "is that the FCC just has to get out of the business of allowing media conglomerates to acquire new licenses or renew existing ones without requiring that every licensee will actually use the public airwaves to serve the public interest." Chairman Kevin Martin opposed this argument by insisting that the FCC is already aggressive on the issue, citing several proposals to increase minority ownership, localism, and programming diversity. All eyes were on the newcomers, Republicans Deborah Taylor Tate and Robert M. McDowell, who will likely have the deciding votes in the FCC's decision. Neither of them seemed prepared to commit definitively to a side. Said McDowell, "Armed with this information - which only you can provide - we at the FCC can analyze today's media marketplace and determine if and how our rules should change."

Gregg Swedberg, **Clear Channel's** OM/Minneapolis has been promoted to RVP/Programming for Minneapolis, Des Moines, Omaha, Cedar Rapids, Iowa City, and Davenport. Clear Channel RVP/Market Manager **Mike Crusham** commented on the promotion in an internal email: "Gregg has a solid reputation as an outstanding programmer and he has demonstrated in the first four months that I have been here that he is the one to take Clear Channel and our audio brands to where we need to be in 2008 and beyond."

NBC Universal Pres./CEO **Jeff Zucker** recently boiled his company's conflict with **Apple** down to one incisive sentence. "Apple has destroyed the music business," he told the moderator of an event organized by the **Newhouse School of Public**



Communications. NBC had pushed for more flexible online pricing of their television programs, but were rebuffed by Apple CEO **Steve Jobs**. "We know that Apple has destroyed the music business in terms of pricing," Zucker expounded, "and if we don't take control, they'll do the same thing on the video side."

CBS Talk WCKG Chicago is anticipated to flip to an AC format next week, according to a **Chicago Sun-Times** report. It will most likely appeal to a 25-54 year old female demographic and be overseen by sister Country WUSN Chicago VP/GM **Dave Robbins**.

Clear Channel AC WNIC Detroit got into the holiday spirit early Thursday morning by starting its annual first-to-Santa-music playlist changover. They made the move in response to a poll in which 60% of the 10,000 respondents said they would like to hear holiday music "November 1st or earlier." However, the reluctant 40% will not be disregarded; the station plans to ease into the festive spirit over time, and continue to spin some secular tunes early on.

The fate of **Cumulus** Talk WWFT (FM Talk 93.9) Indianapolis is up in the air at this point. The station will switch over to Christmas music from mid-November until the New Year, but its fate after that is undetermined. Market Manager **Chris Wheat** got serious, calling the ratings unacceptable and commenting, "**Sean Hannity** can't carry the radio station. One of the glaring things I noticed when I arrived is that there's absolutely no local content from a news and information standpoint." He continued, "We haven't determined what we're going to do with it yet. The options range from tweaking it to changing it."

Wilks Broadcasting AC KCKC (Star 102) Kansas City also hopped onto the sleigh ride bandwagon Wednesday morning and kicked off their 9th year of continuous Holiday programming. In addition to enjoying non-stop holiday music, kids will be able to contact **Santa Claus** on the air between 6 and 7 PM every weeknight starting November 26.

Arnhold and S. Bleichroeder Advisers LLC, who own roughly 5.7% of Emmis' Class A shares recently advised that they "strongly support the idea of a buyout, funded in part by assest sales, that delivers a substantial premium to the current trading price of approximately \$5 per share." It's not the first time such a buyout has been suggested, as CEO Jeff Smulyan essentially proposed the same action last year, though he later withdrew the plan.
