


The HD Radio Alliance's new advertising campaign, previously criticized by some for arguably denigrating traditional AM/FM in favor of the qualities of HD, is now under fire for its method in choosing the creative agency. According to Kurt Hanson's blog on the RAIN website, Adweek reported during the second week of January that the Alliance hired Austin based Omnicom Group's GSD&M Idea **City** to come up with an enticing new campaign to promote HD Radio. The campaign reportedly features the voice of actor **Tom Kenny** (Spongebob Squarepants) as an AM/FM radio acting like a jilted lover because its owner wants or has a HD Radio. The Adweek story includes quotes such as "You know, I could totally pick up those new extra HD stations if I hit the gym...is that what you're into now? Huh? Call me!" These ad spots, according to radio consultants Fred Jacobs and Dave Martin, essentially trash traditional radio to make HD radio look good. Peter Ferrara, HD Radio Alliance CEO, commented on Hanson's January 15th blog article in defense of the campaign, and stated that the Alliance has refused to pull the campaign. In addition, it came to light that there was no chance for various agencies to compete for the account. Jim Murphy posted a comment on Fred Jacobs' blog, noting that the same agency was chosen to design a campaign for the Country Music Association and took a similar tactic (which the CMA refused to run). Ferrara argued that this was false and there was an extensive agency review. For Ferrara, "the bottom line is selling more HD radios." He also responded to the critique of the campaign taking a shot at AM/FM programming in the interest of promoting HD. He encouraged dissenters to view the campaign through "consumer ears", not "radio ears". Ferrara was realistically optimistic about HD Radio's current standings, noting that while consumer awareness is 77%, intent-topurchase is just 33% and 55% in cars. He also stated that this is just one of a variety of campaigns, and on April 1st a new campaign will begin.

Congrats to Conclave Board member **Gary Nolan**, newly named Program Director of AC KOSI 101 (KOSI-FM)/Denver. The appointment is effective January 29, 2008. He had been programming in Ft. Myers, FL for the past year.

In a statement on their website earlier this week. Radio and Records announced they are withdrawing the Lifetime Achievement Award previously announced would be given to **Bob Grant** at the **March** R&R Talk Radio Seminar: "Upon further review and consideration of Bob Grant's complete body of work, Radio and Records has withdrawn its decision to present the 2008 News/Talk/Sports Lifetime Industry Achievement Award to Mr. Grant. R&R is sensitive to the diversity of our community and does not want the presentation of an award to Mr. Grant to imply our endorsement of past comments by him that contradict our values and the respect we have for all members of our community." There was no indication as to what prompted further review. In an interview with All Access, Grant stated, "What R&R did is defamatory and cowardly. I have received support and encouragement from more friends than I knew I had." Grant, whose penchant for controversy is widely known and longstanding in the industry, is best known as a pioneer of political Talk radio from long tenures at WMCA-AM, WABC-AM, and WOR-AM; he presently hosts at WABC. Sean Hannity welcomed Grant as a guest on last Wednesday's show and ripped into R&R for its aboutface. Commentary: It doesn't take long to find Bob Grant on-air quotes, especially those involving a word he's used for people of color in our country, "savages" - "If they didn't observe Martin King Day, there would be trouble from the savages", "(Haitian refugees are) swine and sub-human infiltrators who multiply like maggots on a hot day", "(After the gay pride parade), it would have nice to have a few phalanxes or policemen with machine guns and mow them down." Or the comment that prompted his firing from WABC/NY after he announced then-Commerce Secretary Ron Brown was killed in a plane crash, ""I have a hunch [Brown might be] the lone survivor. But then I'm a pessimist at heart." There are more. Despite his venom, Grant has been honored in our industry by the likes of the National Association of Radio Talk Show Hosts and the National Radio Hall of Fame. Perhaps its not too surprising that R&R might think about following their lead and consider an award for Grant. Yes, Grant had every right to utter his hate speech, as despicable as it may be. Withdrawing their lifetime achievement award could not have been easy for R&R, knowing how the industry might respond. But even in an industry that rightly celebrates free speech in America, it takes immense courage - not cowardice, as some have alleged - to differentiate between that freedom and racism. If R&R erred at all in this matter, it's that Grant was ever considered for the recognition in the first place. - TK

One of its lenders, Guggenheim Corporate Funding, LLC, has asked the judge to deny a bid for an additional \$5 million in financing.

CPR will move its noncommercial format Talk KCFR-AM to the 90.1 FM frequency, currently occupied by its Classical KVOD, and will move KVOD and calls to KFDN's 88.1 FM location. KCFR's old 1340 AM frequency will then be sold.

Clear Channel took Adult Standards WMHG-AM (MAGIC 1600)/ Muskegon, MI silent at the end of 2007 with the expiration of an LMA, the Grand Rapids Press reported. WMHG was one of the stations picked up from Cumulus in a station swap announced after Clear Channel applied for FCC approval of its buyout by Bain Capital and Thomas H. Lee Partners. WMHG was subsequently put into the Aloha Station Trust for eventual resale.


