Arbitron Radio Advisory Council Chairman and Cedar Rapids-based **NRG Media** COO Chuck Ducoty talked to the press about the council's meetings in Orlando, saying, ""The theme of our two-day meeting in Orlando was 'sample, sample, sample.' We want the best product we can get out there for the radio business."

The RAC would like the sample to be more focused on 12+ instead of 6+ and have asked Arbitron to "move 6-11 meters into the 12+ sample. We're moving in the right direction," said Ducoty. A webbased TAPSCAN product "will be available this summer."

Former Oldies-Talk KOFI-AM/Kalispell, MT office manager **Kent Etchison's** indictment on mail fraud charges has led to another KOFI resignation, as long-time News Director **George Ostrom** exited Monday after a dispute over his airing the story in the station's newscast. Ostrom was with the station for 53 years and previously owned a share of the station; his decision to run the story apparently precipitated the conflict with management and his departure. Etchison pleaded not guilty to mail fraud charges stemming from the alleged purchase of \$925,000 in office supplies to receive personal incentives from vendors. If convicted, Etchison could be sentenced to up to 20 years in prison, five years of supervised release and a \$250,000 fine.

Brett Favre's retirement announcement sent Entercom Sports WSSP-AM/Milwaukee into 24/7, wall to wall cheese. Morning host Doug Russell stayed late into mid-morning with midday host Mike Wickett. Steve "Sparky" Fifer yakked from 10a-1p and Gary Ellerson and Cliff Saunders put it to bed from 1p-7p. The station pre-empted Premiere's Jim Rome to keep it local.

Jones Radio Networks and Cox Talk WSB-AM/Atlanta personality – and last year's Conclave Learning Conference keynoter – Neal Boortz' new book, FairTax- The Truth: Answering the Critics, has landed at #4 on the New York Times non-fiction best-seller list this week! Broadcasting from 6a-10p on Friday, February 29th, Dick said the money raised, "assures that nearly 5,000 people will be fed and more than 500 will be sheltered every day and night for the next 365 days." Since 1988, the Dick Purtan Radiothon has raised over \$19 million for the Bed and Bread Program.

It's "Chicago Day" Wednesday March 5th, according to **CBS** AA WXRT/Chicago. The station dedicated 9a-9p to the city's favorite musicians, actors, athletes, politicians and fellow citizens, who were heard speaking from the heart on what Chicago means to them. XM Satellite Radio Holdings Inc. and Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. have extended by two months a deadline to potentially terminate without penalty Sirius's year-old proposed acquisition of its bigger rival. Under the original terms of their deal, first announced in February 2007, the companies could have walked away after March 1st if they did not receive regulatory approval. U.S. regulators, including the FCC and Dept. of Justice, have yet to decide whether to approve the merger. Both companies said this week that they are optimistic both agencies will approve the deal.
