The National Association Of Broadcasters said Tuesday that a majority of the House of Representatives now opposes legislation that would require radio stations to pay a performance fee to all artists whose music it plays. With four new signatures, the resolution has 219 co-sponsors, a majority of the 435-member House. Expect to hear plenty about this during Friday's Conclave College Royalties presentation!

The **NAB** continues to urge Congress not to stop the **FCC** from implementing its proposed easing of media ownership rules. NAB Pres./CEO David K. Rehr is calling the FCC's December decision, which would allow newspapers and broadcasters in a given market to buy each other, "a modest relaxation" that "would result in stronger and more sustainable service, as localism is best preserved by permitting broadcasters to compete effectively in the digital multi-channel marketplace." "There is no reason to rescind this modest reform," Rehr said. "First, the ban — adopted in 1975 — and never reformed is outdated. Second, the FCC's decision was made after conducting a number of proceedings over more than a decade. Failure to consider and reform the restriction would have violated the agency's statutory obligation." No doubt, Rehr will address this topic in his Friday keynote!

A CBS Talk WCCO-AM/Minneapolis PT promo-guy, Mike **Kinghorn**, was shot during the Juneteenth festival in Minneapolis Saturday night. Kinghorn's ankle was grazed by a bullet near the WCCO booth at the festival, and two other individuals were shot, none with life-threatening injuries.

Saga's Des Moines cluster teamed with Minnesota broadcasters and the American Red Cross for "Send It South-Relay for Relief" from 7a-10p on Friday (6/20) to raise money for flood victims in Iowa and Southern Minnesota. The event began in Northern Minnesota and aired in 12 markets in the state, moving hour-by-hour to the south. It stopped at the Des Moines Radio Group with a live broadcast on KIOA. The daylong effort was reinforced with live announcements and website donations on all six DMRG stations — Oldies KIOA, AC KLTI, Hot AC KSTZ, Active Rock KAZR, Adult Standards KRNT-AM and Religious KPSZ-AM. "Send It South" donations have already raised \$45,000 and donations are still being collected.

Cumulus Top 40 KBEA/Quad Cities morning man "Red Hot" Brian Scott announces their "Relief Drive" garnered \$65k during a 7-hour live broadcast last Friday (6/20). The cleanup has started and help is still needed with 41k people homeless in lowa alone and damage estimated at \$1.5 billion.
